

# HOUSE BILL No. 4730

March 31, 2009, Introduced by Reps. Bolger, Sheltrown, Leland, Melton, Durhal, Lori, Meadows and Dean and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1985 PA 87, entitled  
"William Van Regenmorter crime victim's rights act,"  
by amending sections 4a, 33b, and 64a (MCL 780.754a, 780.783b, and  
780.814a), as added by 2004 PA 456.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 4a. (1) To facilitate compliance with 15 USC 1681g **AND**  
2       **SECTIONS 11 AND 13 OF THE IDENTITY THEFT PROTECTION ACT, 2004 PA**  
3       **452, MCL 445.71 AND 445.73**, a bona fide victim of identity theft is  
4       entitled to file a police report with a law enforcement agency in a  
5       jurisdiction where the alleged violation of identity theft may be  
6       prosecuted as provided under section 10c of chapter II of the code  
7       of criminal procedure, 1927 PA 175, MCL 762.10c, and to obtain a  
8       copy of that report from that law enforcement agency.

Sec. 33b. (1) To facilitate compliance with 15 USC 1681g **AND SECTIONS 11 AND 13 OF THE IDENTITY THEFT PROTECTION ACT, 2004 PA 452, MCL 445.71 AND 445.73**, a bona fide victim of identity theft is entitled to file a police report with a law enforcement agency in a jurisdiction where the alleged violation of identity theft may be prosecuted as provided under section 10c of chapter II of the code of criminal procedure, 1927 PA 175, MCL 762.10c, and to obtain a copy of that report from that law enforcement agency.
