

# HOUSE BILL No. 4733

(As amended September 9, 2009)

March 31, 2009, Introduced by Reps. Johnson, Sheltroun, Leland, Melton, Durhal, Lori, Meadows and Dean and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 2004 PA 452, entitled  
"Identity theft protection act,"  
(MCL 445.61 to 445.77) by adding section 12d.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           SEC. 12D. A PERSON THAT KNOWINGLY VIOLATES SECTION 12C MAY BE  
2 ORDERED TO PAY A CIVIL FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$10,000.00 FOR EACH  
3 VIOLATION. THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OR A PROSECUTING ATTORNEY MAY BRING  
4 AN ACTION TO RECOVER A CIVIL FINE UNDER THIS SECTION. THIS SECTION  
5 DOES NOT AFFECT THE AVAILABILITY OF ANY CIVIL REMEDY FOR A  
6 VIOLATION OF STATE OR FEDERAL LAW.

[Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect January 1, 2010.]
