THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 40111a. (1) By September 1, 1999, the THE commission,
- 2 after consultation with the commission of agriculture, shall issue
- 3 in the manner provided in section 40113a an order concerning deer
- 4 and elk feeding IN THIS STATE. The order shall take effect October
- 5 1, 1999 and shall do all of the following in the lower peninsula:
- 6 (a) Prohibit a person from engaging in deer or elk feeding
- 7 unless the deer or elk feeding is for recreational viewing
- 8 purposes.
- 9 (b) Require that the feed be deposited or distributed not more
- 10 than 100 yards from the residence of the person engaged in deer or

- 1 elk feeding for recreational viewing purposes on land owned or
- 2 possessed by that person.
- 3 (c) Establish any other reasonable conditions for deer and elk
- 4 feeding for recreational viewing purposes that are consistent with
- 5 the requirements of this section.
- 6 (2) The order issued under subsection (1) shall also establish
- 7 criteria for deer feeding in the Upper Peninsula.
- 8 (3) Notwithstanding subsections (1) and (2), the commission,
- 9 after consultation with the commission of agriculture, may issue in
- 10 the manner provided in section 40113a an order that prohibits all
- 11 deer and elk feeding in all or part of this state if the commission
- 12 considers the prohibition to be necessary to properly manage
- 13 wildlife populations or to control or eradicate disease.
- 14 (4) An order under this part concerning baiting to take deer
- 15 or elk or concerning deer or elk feeding shall not make a
- 16 distinction between the depositing or distributing of feed by hand
- 17 and the depositing or distributing of feed by a mechanical device,
- 18 whether the mechanical device is operated by human power or
- 19 otherwise.
- 20 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "DEER AND ELK FEEDING" MEANS THE
- 21 DEPOSITING, DISTRIBUTING, OR TENDING OF FEED IN AN AREA FREQUENTED
- 22 BY WILD, FREE-RANGING WHITE-TAILED DEER AND ELK TO PREVENT THEM
- 23 FROM STARVING OR FOR RECREATIONAL VIEWING. DEER AND ELK FEEDING
- 24 DOES NOT INCLUDE ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 25 (A) BAITING TO TAKE GAME AS PROVIDED BY AN ORDER OF THE
- 26 COMMISSION UNDER SECTION 40113A.
- 27 (B) THE SCATTERING OF FEED SOLELY AS THE RESULT OF NORMAL

- LOGGING PRACTICES OR NORMAL AGRICULTURAL PRACTICES. 1
- 2 (C) THE STORAGE OR USE OF FEED FOR AGRICULTURAL PURPOSES IF 1
- OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY:
- (i) THE AREA IS OCCUPIED BY LIVESTOCK ACTIVELY CONSUMING THE 4
- FEED ON A DAILY BASIS. 5
- (ii) THE FEED IS COVERED TO DETER WILD, FREE-RANGING WHITE-6
- 7 TAILED DEER AND ELK FROM GAINING ACCESS TO THE FEED OR IS BEING
- USED ON A DAILY BASIS. 8
- 9 (iii) THE FEED IS IN A STORAGE FACILITY OR IS STORED IN A MANNER
- 10 THAT IS CONSISTENT WITH NORMAL AGRICULTURAL PRACTICES.
- 11 (D) FEEDING WILD BIRDS OR OTHER WILDLIFE IF DONE IN SUCH A
- 12 MANNER AS TO EXCLUDE WILD, FREE-RANGING WHITE-TAILED DEER AND ELK
- FROM GAINING ACCESS TO THE FEED. 13
