SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5456

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law,"

(MCL 168.1 to 168.992) by adding section 759e.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 759E. (1) EACH CITY OR TOWNSHIP CLERK SHALL MAINTAIN A
- 2 PERMANENT ABSENT VOTER LIST.
- 3 (2) EACH COUNTY, CITY, OR TOWNSHIP CLERK MAY MAIL TO EACH
- 4 REGISTERED ELECTOR IN THE COUNTY, CITY, OR TOWNSHIP A NOTICE
- 5 INDICATING THAT THE ELECTOR MAY REQUEST TO BE PLACED ON THE
- 6 PERMANENT ABSENT VOTER LIST OF THE CITY OR TOWNSHIP IN WHICH THE
- 7 ELECTOR IS REGISTERED TO VOTE.
- 8 (3) IF A CITY OR TOWNSHIP CLERK MAINTAINS A PERMANENT ABSENT

- 1 VOTER LIST ON OR BEFORE THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT
- 2 THAT ADDED THIS SECTION, THE CITY OR TOWNSHIP CLERK MAY CONTINUE TO
- 3 MAINTAIN THAT LIST AS ITS PERMANENT ABSENT VOTER LIST.
- 4 (4) EACH VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATION PRODUCED BY THE STATE
- 5 OF MICHIGAN SHALL INCLUDE A SPACE FOR THE ELECTOR TO MARK IF THE
- 6 ELECTOR WISHES TO BE LISTED ON THE PERMANENT ABSENT VOTER LIST OF
- 7 THE CITY OR TOWNSHIP IN WHICH THE ELECTOR IS REGISTERED TO VOTE. IN
- 8 ADDITION, EACH ABSENT VOTER BALLOT APPLICATION AS PRESCRIBED UNDER
- 9 SECTION 759 AND DISTRIBUTED BY A COUNTY, CITY, TOWNSHIP, OR VILLAGE
- 10 CLERK SHALL INCLUDE A SPACE FOR THE ELECTOR TO MARK IF THE ELECTOR
- 11 WISHES TO BE LISTED ON THE PERMANENT ABSENT VOTER LIST OF THE CITY
- 12 OR TOWNSHIP IN WHICH THE ELECTOR IS REGISTERED TO VOTE.
- 13 (5) IN ADDITION TO SUBSECTION (4), A QUALIFIED AND REGISTERED
- 14 ELECTOR MAY REQUEST TO BE PLACED ON THE PERMANENT ABSENT VOTER LIST
- 15 OF THE CITY OR TOWNSHIP IN WHICH THE ELECTOR IS REGISTERED TO VOTE.
- 16 A REQUEST BY AN ELECTOR UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE MADE TO THE
- 17 CITY OR TOWNSHIP CLERK IN PERSON OR BY TELEPHONE, FACSIMILE
- 18 COMMUNICATION, ELECTRONIC MAIL, OR FIRST-CLASS MAIL.
- 19 (6) THE REQUEST OF EACH REGISTERED AND QUALIFIED ELECTOR TO BE
- 20 PLACED ON THE PERMANENT ABSENT VOTER LIST SHALL BE ENTERED IN THE
- 21 QUALIFIED VOTER FILE IN THE SAME MANNER AS DATA ARE ENTERED FOR A
- 22 NEW ELECTOR.
- 23 (7) THE COUNTY, CITY, TOWNSHIP, OR VILLAGE CLERK RESPONSIBLE
- 24 FOR ISSUING ABSENT VOTER BALLOTS FOR AN ELECTION SHALL SEND TO EACH
- 25 ELECTOR ON THE PERMANENT ABSENT VOTER LIST AN APPLICATION FOR AN
- 26 ABSENT VOTER BALLOT FOR THE ELECTION.
- 27 (8) A QUALIFIED AND REGISTERED ELECTOR MAY REQUEST TO BE

- REMOVED FROM THE PERMANENT ABSENT VOTER LIST OF THE CITY OR 1
- 2 TOWNSHIP. A REQUEST BY AN ELECTOR UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE
- 3 MADE TO THE CITY OR TOWNSHIP CLERK IN PERSON OR BY TELEPHONE,
- FACSIMILE COMMUNICATION, ELECTRONIC MAIL, OR FIRST-CLASS MAIL. 4
- (9) EVERY JANUARY, THE CITY OR TOWNSHIP CLERK MAY REMOVE AN 5
- 6 ELECTOR FROM THE PERMANENT ABSENT VOTER LIST IF THE ELECTOR HAS NOT
- REQUESTED AN ABSENT VOTER BALLOT IN ANY ELECTION HELD IN THE 7
- PREVIOUS 4 CONSECUTIVE YEARS. 8
- 9 (10) IF AN ELECTOR IS ON A PERMANENT ABSENT VOTER LIST AND THE
- 10 ELECTOR CHANGES HIS OR HER RESIDENCE, THE ELECTOR'S REQUEST TO BE
- 11 ON A PERMANENT ABSENT VOTER LIST SHALL AUTOMATICALLY CONTINUE AND
- 12 THE ELECTOR SHALL BE LISTED ON THE PERMANENT ABSENT VOTER LIST OF
- 13 THE CITY OR TOWNSHIP IN WHICH THE ELECTOR IS REGISTERED TO VOTE.
