

**SUBSTITUTE FOR  
HOUSE BILL NO. 5533**

A bill to amend 1966 PA 331, entitled  
"Community college act of 1966,"  
by amending section 121 (MCL 389.121), as amended by 1997 PA 135.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           Sec. 121. The board of trustees of the community college  
2 district has the power to make plans for, to promote, or to  
3 acquire, construct, own, develop, maintain, and operate a community  
4 college and an area vocational-technical education program. The  
5 board of trustees may do all of the following:

6           (a) Locate, acquire, purchase, or lease in the name of the  
7 community college district a site or sites within or without the  
8 territory of the community college district for college buildings,  
9 libraries, agricultural farms, athletic fields, playgrounds,  
10 stadiums, gymnasiums, auditoriums, parking areas, residence halls,

1 and supporting facilities as may be necessary; purchase, lease,  
2 acquire, erect or build and equip buildings, structures, and other  
3 improvements for college or area vocational-technical education  
4 buildings, libraries, agricultural farms, athletic fields,  
5 playgrounds, stadiums, gymnasiums, auditoriums, parking areas,  
6 residence halls, and supporting facilities as may be necessary;  
7 enter into installment purchase contracts for real or personal  
8 property; pay for real or personal property out of the funds of the  
9 community college district provided for that purpose; sell or  
10 exchange any real or personal property of the community college  
11 district that is no longer required for school purposes, and give  
12 proper deeds, bills of sale, or other instruments passing title to  
13 the real or personal property.

14 (b) Establish and carry on schools and departments or courses  
15 of study and other educational programs as may be consistent with  
16 the purposes of this act, and take over and succeed to the  
17 operation of a community college or vocational-technical department  
18 or departments previously operated by school districts within the  
19 community college district.

20 (c) Establish, equip, and maintain agricultural, trade, and  
21 other vocational-technical departments and have general control  
22 over them for community college or area vocational-technical  
23 program purposes.

24 **(D) ESTABLISH EDUCATION PROGRAMS AND GRANT A BACHELOR OF**  
25 **SCIENCE IN NURSING DEGREE OR ANY BACCALAUREATE DEGREE IN CEMENT**  
26 **TECHNOLOGY, MARITIME TECHNOLOGY, OR CULINARY ARTS.**

27 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect

1 unless House Bill No. 4837 of the 95th Legislature is enacted into  
2 law.
