## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5666

## A bill to amend 1989 PA 196, entitled

"An act to abolish the criminal assessments commission; to prescribe certain duties of the crime victim services commission; to create the crime victim's rights fund; to provide for expenditures from the fund; to provide for assessments against criminal defendants and certain juvenile offenders; to provide for payment of crime victim's rights services; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies and departments,"

by amending section 4 (MCL 780.904), as amended by 2008 PA 396.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4. (1) The crime victim's rights fund is created as a
- 2 separate fund in the state treasury. The state treasurer shall
- 3 credit to the fund all amounts received under this act and as
- 4 provided by law. The state treasurer shall invest fund money in the
- 5 same manner as surplus funds are invested under section 3 of 1855

- 1 PA 105, MCL 21.143. Earnings from the fund shall be credited to the
- 2 fund.
- 3 (2) The fund shall be expended only as provided in this act.
- 4 Amounts in the fund in excess of the necessary revenue determined
- 5 by the commission under section 3(a) may be used for crime victim
- 6 compensation under 1976 PA 223, MCL 18.351 to 18.368. Before
- 7 October 1, 2009, any ANY additional excess revenue that has not
- 8 been used for crime victim compensation may be used to provide any
- 9 of the following services:
- 10 (A) BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2010, ANY OF THE FOLLOWING SERVICES:
- 11 (i) (a)—The operation and enhancement of the sex offender
- 12 registry compiled and maintained under the sex offenders
- 13 registration act, 1994 PA 295, MCL 28.721 to 28.736.
- 14 (ii) (b) The Amber alert program under the Michigan Amber alert
- 15 act, 2002 PA 712, MCL 28.751 to 28.754.
- 16 (iii) (c)—Treatment services for victims of conduct prohibited
- 17 under sections 520b to 520g of the Michigan penal code, 1931 PA
- 18 328, MCL 750.520b to 750.520q.
- 19 (iv) (d) Polygraph examination as that term is defined under
- 20 section 2 of the polygraph protection act of 1981, 1982 PA 44, MCL
- **21** 37.202.
- 22 (v) (e)—The expert witness testimony of a forensic scientist.
- 23 (B) THE ESTABLISHMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF A STATEWIDE TRAUMA
- 24 SYSTEM, INCLUDING STAFF SUPPORT ASSOCIATED WITH TRAUMA AND RELATED
- 25 EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PROGRAM ACTIVITIES. NOT MORE THAN
- 26 \$3,500,000.00 SHALL BE EXPENDED FOR THIS PURPOSE FROM THE FUND IN
- 27 ANY FISCAL YEAR.

- (C) BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2014, THE AMOUNT EXPENDED FOR THE 1
- 2 STATEWIDE TRAUMA SYSTEM FROM THE FUND SHALL NOT EXCEED 50% OF THE
- 3 MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE UNDER SUBDIVISION (B), UNLESS THE AMOUNT EXPENDED
- 4 IS REASONABLY PROPORTIONAL TO CRIME VICTIMS' UTILIZATION OF THE
- 5 STATEWIDE TRAUMA SYSTEM.
