## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5686

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 205 (MCL 257.205), as amended by 1980 PA 398.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 205. (1) The secretary of state shall maintain an office
- 2 in the state capitol complex —and in other places in the state as
- 3 the secretary of state HE OR SHE considers necessary to carry out
- 4 the powers and duties vested in the secretary of state.
- 5 At least 1 office shall be established in each county of the state
- 6 and in each city of the state having a population of 10,000 or
- 7 more, but not within a radius of 5 miles from a county office
- 8 location. This subsection does not apply in a county having a
- 9 population of 300,000 or more, nor to contiguous cities having a
- 10 combined population of 10,000 or more.

- 1 (2) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL MAINTAIN AN OFFICE IN
- 2 EXISTENCE AND OPERATING ON DECEMBER 1, 2009 THAT WAS LOCATED IN A
- 3 CITY OR TOWNSHIP HAVING A POPULATION OF 10,000 OR MORE.
- 4 (3) A person licensed AS A DEALER under section 248 —is not
- 5 eligible for appointment to conduct, manage, or be an employee of a
- 6 branch or fee office of the secretary of state.
- 7 (4)  $\frac{(2)}{}$  A bond may be required of a person in an office
- 8 established under subsection (1) in an amount that the secretary of
- 9 state prescribes to cover the safe handling of money received under
- 10 this act. The secretary of state shall not be held personally
- 11 liable for a loss of money because of armed robbery, larceny,
- 12 embezzlement, riot, act of God, or other act of a person resulting
- in a loss of money which is within the authority and responsibility
- 14 of the secretary of state as the administrator of this act.
- 15 (5) (3) A person appointed to conduct a branch office shall
- 16 receive THE NECESSARY EXPENSES OF THE OFFICE AND compensation TO BE
- 17 fixed by the secretary of state. 7 and necessary expenses of the
- 18 office. The compensation and expenses shall be paid out of the
- 19 Michigan transportation fund ESTABLISHED IN SECTION 10 OF 1951 PA
- 20 51, MCL 247.660, and shall be deducted from the fund before the
- 21 fund is certified to the state treasurer.
