## SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4932

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 310b (MCL 750.310b), as added by 1996 PA 539.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 310b. (1) This chapter does not apply to a redemption
- 2 game if all of the following conditions are met:
- 3 (a) The outcome of the game is determined through the
- 4 application of an element of skill by the player.
- 5 (b) The award of the prize is based upon the player's
- 6 achieving the object of the game or otherwise upon the player's
- 7 score.
- 8 (c) Only noncash prizes, toys, novelties, or coupons or other
- 9 representations of value redeemable for noncash prizes, toys, or

- 1 novelties are awarded. A GIFT CARD MAY BE AWARDED UNDER THIS
- 2 SUBDIVISION IF ALL OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY:
- 3 (i) THE GIFT CARD IS USABLE ONLY AT A RETAILER OR AN AFFILIATED
- 4 GROUP OF RETAILERS.
- 5 (ii) THE GIFT CARD IS ISSUED IN A SPECIFIED AMOUNT.
- 6 (iii) THE GIFT CARD IS REDEEMABLE ONLY FOR GOODS AND SERVICES
- 7 AVAILABLE FROM THE RETAILER AND NOT FOR CASH.
- 8 (iv) INFORMATION ON THE GIFT CARD MAY NOT BE ALTERED WITH THE
- 9 USE OF A PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION NUMBER.
- 10 (d) The wholesale value of a prize, toy, or novelty awarded
- 11 for the successful single play of a game is not more than \$3.75.
- 12 (e) The redemption value of coupons or other representations
- 13 of value awarded for the successful single play of a game does not
- 14 exceed 15 times the amount charged for a single play of the game or
- 15 A \$3.75-PER-PLAY AVERAGE, whichever is less. However, players may
- 16 accumulate coupons or other representations of value for redemption
- 17 for noncash prizes, toys, or novelties of a greater value up to,
- 18 but not exceeding, \$250.00 \$500.00 wholesale value.
- 19 (2) As used in this section: , "redemption
- 20 (A) "NONCASH PRIZES, TOYS, OR NOVELTIES" INCLUDES A PLAY ON A
- 21 GAME OF CHANCE, BINGO, OR INSTANT BINGO OR A STATE LOTTERY TICKET.
- 22 (B) "REDEMPTION game" means a single player or multi-player
- 23 MULTIPLAYER mechanical, electronic, or manual amusement device
- 24 involving a game, the object of which is throwing, rolling,
- 25 bowling, shooting, placing, propelling, or stopping a ball or other
- 26 object into, upon, or against a hole or other target. Redemption
- 27 game does not include either of the following:

- 1 (i) (a) Games A GAME such as roulette, beano, cards, dice,
- 2 wheels WHEEL of fortune, video poker, A slot machines MACHINE, or
- 3 other games ANOTHER GAME in which winning depends primarily upon
- 4 fortuitous or accidental circumstances beyond the control of the
- 5 player.
- 6 (ii) (b)—A game that includes a mechanical or physical device
- 7 which THAT directly or indirectly impairs or thwarts the skill of
- 8 the player.
