## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5245

A bill to amend 1980 PA 299, entitled "Occupational code,"

(MCL 339.101 to 339.2919) by adding section 1809b.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1809B. (1) A PERSON LICENSED IN THE PRACTICE OF MORTUARY
- 2 SCIENCE MAY COMPILE A LIST OF NAMES OF THE UNCLAIMED CREMATED
- 3 REMAINS HELD IN HIS OR HER POSSESSION FOR 6 MONTHS OR MORE FOR THE
- 4 PURPOSES OF DETERMINING WHETHER 1 OR MORE OF THE DECEASED IS A
- 5 VETERAN OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED SERVICES.
- 6 (2) THE FUNERAL DIRECTOR MAY RELEASE THE LIST OF NAMES TO ANY
- 7 FEDERALLY CHARTERED VETERANS SERVICE ORGANIZATION TO CONFIRM WITH
- 8 THE NATIONAL CEMETERY ADMINISTRATION'S CENTRAL SCHEDULING OFFICE IN
- 9 ST. LOUIS, MISSOURI, WHETHER THE DECEASED IS ELIGIBLE FOR PROPER
- 10 DISPOSITION AT A VETERANS CEMETERY. THE VETERANS SERVICE
- 11 ORGANIZATION SHALL REPORT TO THE FUNERAL DIRECTOR REGARDING THE

- NAMES OF THE CONFIRMED VETERANS OR SPOUSES OF VETERANS. 1
- 2 (3) IF THE UNCLAIMED CREMATED REMAINS ARE DETERMINED TO BE
- 3 ELIGIBLE FOR PROPER DISPOSITION AT A VETERANS CEMETERY, THE FUNERAL
- DIRECTOR SHALL SEND WRITTEN NOTICE OF INTENT TO MAKE A PROPER 4
- DISPOSITION OF THE UNCLAIMED REMAINS AS DESCRIBED UNDER SECTION 5
- 6 1809A(1). IF THE UNCLAIMED CREMATED REMAINS OF A CONFIRMED VETERAN
- ARE NOT CLAIMED BY THE PERSONS TO WHOM THE NOTICE WAS SENT, THE 7
- FUNERAL DIRECTOR MAY ARRANGE FOR THE PROPER DISPOSITION OF THE 8
- REMAINS WITH A STATE OR NATIONAL VETERANS CEMETERY.
- 10 (4) A FUNERAL DIRECTOR COMPLYING WITH THIS SECTION IS IMMUNE
- 11 FROM CRIMINAL OR CIVIL LIABILITY ARISING FROM COMPLIANCE WITH THIS
- 12 SECTION.
- 13 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect July 1,
- 14 2010.
- 15 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 16 unless House Bill No. 5246 of the 95th Legislature is enacted into
- 17 law.
