SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5777

A bill to regulate the use of ropes, chains, wires, or similar devices in blocking access to certain land; and to provide for penalties.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Farm" and "farm product" mean those terms as defined in
- 3 section 2 of the Michigan right to farm act, 1981 PA 93, MCL
- **4** 286.472.
- 5 (b) "Farm property" means land on a farm used in the
- 6 production of 1 or more farm products and any contiguous land under
- 7 common ownership.
- 8 (c) "Hunter orange" means the color described in section 40116
- 9 of the natural resources and environmental protection act, 1994 PA

- **1** 451, MCL 324.40116.
- 2 (d) "Person" means an individual, partnership, corporation,
- 3 association, governmental entity, or other legal entity.
- 4 (e) "Point of entry" means a road or path suitable for use by
- 5 a motorized vehicle, including a motorcycle, all terrain vehicle,
- 6 or snowmobile.
- 7 Sec. 2. Except as provided in section 3, a person shall not
- 8 use a rope, chain, wire, or similar device as a barrier across a
- 9 point of entry to prevent access to land unless both of the
- 10 following conditions are met:
- 11 (a) The rope, chain, wire, or similar device is the color
- 12 hunter orange or is enclosed in material that is the color hunter
- 13 orange.
- 14 (b) The rope, chain, wire, or similar device is not more than
- 15 30 inches above the ground at any point.
- Sec. 3. Section 2 does not apply to a farm property.
- 17 Sec. 4. A person who violates this act is responsible for a
- 18 state civil infraction and may be ordered to pay a civil fine of
- 19 not more than \$250.00.
- 20 Enacting section 1. This act takes effect 180 days after the
- 21 date it is enacted into law.
