SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 432

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998," by amending section 513 (MCL 436.1513), as amended by 2007 PA 11.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 513. (1) The commission may issue to the governing board
- 2 of a college or university, without regard to the quota provisions
- 3 of section 531, a license to sell alcoholic liquor for consumption
- 4 on the premises of a conference center operated by the governing
- 5 board. Licenses granted under this subsection may be used only for
- 6 the sale of alcoholic liquor at regularly scheduled conference
- 7 center activities. The sale of alcoholic liquor to unscheduled
- 8 patrons or at unscheduled events is prohibited under this

- 2 (2) Subject to the provisions of section 531, the commission
- 3 may issue a license to a private entity for the sale of alcoholic
- 4 liquor for consumption on the premises of a hotel located on land

- 7 (a) The land is leased or subleased at fair market value to a
- 8 private entity that owns, leases, or subleases the hotel building

- 13 (3) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 531, THE COMMISSION
- 14 MAY ISSUE A LICENSE TO A PRIVATE ENTITY FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC
- 15 LIQUOR FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE LICENSED PREMISES OF A RESTAURANT
- 16 LOCATED ON LAND OWNED BY WAYNE STATE UNIVERSITY IF BOTH OF THE
- 17 FOLLOWING CIRCUMSTANCES EXIST:
- 18 (A) THE LAND IS LEASED OR SUBLEASED AT FAIR MARKET VALUE TO A
- 19 PRIVATE ENTITY THAT OWNS, LEASES, OR SUBLEASES THE [LICENSED PREMISES FOR THE OPERATION OF A] RESTAURANT.
- 20 (B) THE RESTAURANT IS LOCATED WITHIN AN AREA DESIGNATED FOR
- 21 INDUSTRIAL, RESEARCH, OR COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENT BY THE GOVERNING
- 22 BOARD OF WAYNE STATE UNIVERSITY.
- 23 (4) (3) Licenses issued pursuant to this section are
- 24 nontransferable, and the licensee shall pay the fee required under
- 25 section 525.
- 26 (5) $\frac{(4)}{}$ As used in this section:
- 27 (a) "College" or "university" means a 2-year or 4-year state

- 2 (b) "Conference center" means a building or portion of a
- 3 building, other than a student residence hall or student center,
- 4 which has meeting rooms, banquet areas, social halls, overnight
- 5 accommodations, and related facilities for special activities
- 6 scheduled by the college or university, which in the judgment of
- 7 the commission, has been regularly used for conferences and lodging
- 8 of guests. The convocation center and the corporate education
- 9 center at eastern Michigan university, the Kirkhof and Eberhard
- 10 centers at Grand Valley state university, the Bernhard center at
- 11 western Michigan university, the Wadsworth center at Michigan
- 12 technological university, the West complex at Saginaw Valley state
- 13 university, the conference center at Big Rapids, the applied
- 14 technology center at Grand Rapids and the FSU-GR conference center
- 15 of Ferris state university, Grand Rapids junior college, the
- 16 Waterman campus center at Schoolcraft college, the Mendel center at
- 17 Lake Michigan community college, the McGregor memorial conference
- 18 center at Wayne state university, the Michigan state university
- 19 management educational center, the Superior dome at northern
- 20 Michigan university, the Walker Cisler center at Lake Superior
- 21 state university, the Marie Prahl college center at Mott community
- 22 college, the John T. Parsons and Frank L. Stulen Michigan technical
- 23 education center, the Gerald and Frances Oleson center, the Dennos
- 24 museum center, and the Great Lakes campus at northwestern Michigan
- 25 college, the farmhouse at Delta college, the Oakland community
- 26 college culinary studies institute, and the performing arts and
- 27 cultural center complex at Macomb community college are considered
