- 5 (2) A copy of the current sanitary survey report from the

- 7 safe drinking water act, 1976 PA 399, MCL 325.1001 to 325.1023, and
- 8 the water sample results required under that act shall be available
 - at the bottling plant for the director to demonstrate approval of

- 2 (3) Bottled water shall not contain any substance in excess of
- 3 the maximum contaminant level adopted for drinking water under the

- 6 conspicuously labeled with the declaration of identity of the
