SUBSTITUTE FOR

SENATE BILL NO. 1085

A bill to amend 1967 (Ex Sess) PA 8, entitled

"An act to provide for intergovernmental transfers of functions and responsibilities," $\;$

by amending section 4 (MCL 124.534).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4. A contract shall include:
- 2 (a) A description of the functions or responsibilities to be
- 3 transferred.
- 4 (b) The effective date of the contract.
- 5 (c) The term of operation under the contract.
- 6 (d) The manner in which the affected employees, if any, of the
- 7 participating political subdivisions shall be transferred,
- 8 reassigned, or otherwise treated subject to the following:

- 1 (i) Such THE employees as are necessary for the operation
- 2 thereof shall be transferred to and appointed as employees subject
- 3 to all rights and benefits. These employees shall be given
- 4 seniority credits and sick leave, vacation, insurance, and pension
- 5 credits in accordance with the records or labor agreements from the
- 6 acquired system. Members and beneficiaries of any pension or
- 7 retirement system or other benefits established by the acquired
- 8 system shall continue to have rights, privileges, benefits,
- 9 obligations, and status with respect to such THE established
- 10 system. The political subdivision to which the functions or
- 11 responsibilities have been transferred shall assume the obligations
- 12 of any system acquired by it with regard to wages, salaries, hours,
- 13 working conditions, sick leave, health and welfare, and pension or
- 14 retirement provisions for employees. If the employees of an
- 15 acquired system were not guaranteed sick leave, health and welfare,
- 16 and pension or retirement pay based on seniority, the political
- 17 subdivision shall not be required to provide these benefits
- 18 retroactively.
- 19 (ii) No employee who is transferred to a position with the
- 20 political subdivision shall by reason of such THAT transfer be
- 21 placed in any worse position UNTIL A NEW LABOR AGREEMENT IS IN
- 22 PLACE with respect to workmen's WORKER'S compensation, pension,
- 23 seniority, wages, sick leave, vacation, health and welfare
- 24 insurance, or any other benefits that he OR SHE enjoyed as an
- 25 employee of such THE acquired system.
- 26 (iii) NOTHING IN THIS ACT REQUIRES THAT THE POLITICAL
- 27 SUBDIVISION PAY TO EMPLOYEES THE HIGHEST WAGES AND BENEFITS

- 1 PREVIOUSLY PAID TO ANY OF THE EMPLOYEES OR THEIR PREEXISTING
- 2 BARGAINING UNITS.
- 3 (iv) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBPARAGRAPH (iii), ALL EXISTING AND EXPIRED
- 4 LABOR CONTRACTS WITH AN ACQUIRED SYSTEM SHALL BE ASSUMED BY THE
- 5 POLITICAL SUBDIVISION AND REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL A NEW LABOR
- 6 AGREEMENT IS IN PLACE.
- 7 (e) The manner in which any real property, facilities,
- 8 equipment, or other personal property required in the execution of
- 9 the contract shall be transferred, sold, or otherwise disposed of
- 10 between the contracting parties.
- 11 (f) The method of financing to be used and the amount to be
- 12 paid by each of the participating units in relation to the
- 13 undertaking involved.
- 14 (g) Other legal, financial, and administrative arrangements
- 15 necessary to effectuate the undertaking.
