HOUSE BILL No. 4075

January 22, 2009, Introduced by Rep. Corriveau and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 2001 PA 34, entitled "Revised municipal finance act,"

(MCL 141.2101 to 141.2821) by adding section 518.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 518. (1) THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2010, A COUNTY, CITY,
- 2 VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP MAY BY ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION OF ITS
- 3 GOVERNING BODY, AND WITHOUT A VOTE OF ITS ELECTORS, ISSUE A
- 4 MUNICIPAL SECURITY UNDER THIS SECTION TO PAY THE COSTS OF THE
- 5 UNFUNDED ACCRUED LIABILITY PROVIDED THAT THE AMOUNT OF TAXES
- 6 NECESSARY TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL AND INTEREST ON THAT MUNICIPAL
- 7 SECURITY, TOGETHER WITH THE TAXES LEVIED FOR THE SAME YEAR, SHALL
- 8 NOT EXCEED THE LIMIT AUTHORIZED BY LAW. POSTEMPLOYMENT HEALTH CARE
- 9 BENEFITS MAY BE FUNDED BY THE COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP,
- 10 NOTWITHSTANDING THE FACT THAT THE COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE, OR

- 1 TOWNSHIP HAS NO LEGAL OBLIGATION TO PAY THE BENEFITS OR HAS THE
- 2 RIGHT TO ALTER OR ELIMINATE THE PAYMENT OF THOSE BENEFITS. THE
- 3 FUNDING OF POSTEMPLOYMENT HEALTH CARE BENEFITS BY A COUNTY, CITY,
- 4 VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP AS PROVIDED IN THIS ACT SHALL NOT CONSTITUTE A
- 5 CONTRACT TO PAY THE POSTEMPLOYMENT HEALTH CARE BENEFITS.
- 6 (2) BEFORE A COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP ISSUES A
- 7 MUNICIPAL SECURITY UNDER THIS SECTION, THE COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE,
- 8 OR TOWNSHIP SHALL PUBLISH A NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE THE MUNICIPAL
- 9 SECURITY. THE NOTICE OF INTENT AND THE RIGHTS OF REFERENDUM SHALL
- 10 MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 517(2) EXCEPT THAT PETITIONERS
- 11 SHALL HAVE 60 DAYS AFTER THE PUBLICATION OF THE NOTICE OF INTENT TO
- 12 FILE A PETITION AND THE REGISTERED ELECTOR REQUIREMENT SHALL BE NOT
- 13 LESS THAN 5% OR 10,000 REGISTERED ELECTORS, WHICHEVER IS LESS.
- 14 (3) A COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP BY RESOLUTION AND
- 15 WITH A VOTE OF ITS ELECTORS MAY ISSUE A MUNICIPAL SECURITY PLEDGING
- 16 ITS UNLIMITED TAXES TO PAY THE COSTS OF AN UNFUNDED ACCRUED
- 17 LIABILITY.
- 18 (4) THE PROCEEDS OF A MUNICIPAL SECURITY ISSUED UNDER THIS
- 19 SECTION MAY BE USED TO PAY THE COSTS OF ISSUANCE OF THE MUNICIPAL
- 20 SECURITY. THE PROCEEDS OF A MUNICIPAL SECURITY ISSUED UNDER THIS
- 21 SECTION SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN A HEALTH CARE TRUST FUND; A TRUST
- 22 CREATED BY THE ISSUER WHICH HAS AS ITS BENEFICIARY A HEALTH CARE
- 23 TRUST FUND; OR FOR A COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP, A
- 24 RESTRICTED FUND WITHIN A TRUST THAT WOULD ONLY BE USED TO RETIRE
- 25 THE MUNICIPAL SECURITIES ISSUED UNDER SUBSECTION (1) OR (3). A
- 26 COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO CREATE A
- 27 TRUST TO CARRY OUT THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION. THE TRUST

- 1 CREATED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL INVEST ITS FUNDS IN THE SAME
- 2 MANNER AS FUNDS INVESTED BY A HEALTH CARE TRUST FUND. THE TRUST
- 3 CREATED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL COMPLY WITH ALL OF THE
- 4 FOLLOWING:
- 5 (A) REPORT ITS FINANCIAL CONDITION ACCORDING TO GENERALLY
- 6 ACCEPTED ACCOUNTING PRINCIPLES.
- 7 (B) BE TAX EXEMPT UNDER THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE.
- 8 (5) BEFORE A COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP ISSUES A
- 9 MUNICIPAL SECURITY UNDER THIS SECTION, THE COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE,
- 10 OR TOWNSHIP SHALL PREPARE AND MAKE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC A
- 11 COMPREHENSIVE FINANCIAL PLAN THAT INCLUDES ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 12 (A) EVIDENCE THAT THE ISSUANCE OF THE MUNICIPAL SECURITY
- 13 TOGETHER WITH OTHER FUNDS LAWFULLY AVAILABLE WILL BE SUFFICIENT TO
- 14 ELIMINATE THE UNFUNDED ACCRUED LIABILITY.
- 15 (B) A DEBT SERVICE AMORTIZATION SCHEDULE AND A DESCRIPTION OF
- 16 ACTIONS REQUIRED TO SATISFY THE DEBT SERVICE AMORTIZATION SCHEDULE.
- 17 (C) A CERTIFICATION BY THE PERSON PREPARING THE PLAN THAT THE
- 18 COMPREHENSIVE FINANCIAL PLAN IS COMPLETE AND ACCURATE.
- 19 (D) DOCUMENTATION THAT THE ISSUANCE OF MUNICIPAL SECURITIES
- 20 WILL RESULT IN PROJECTED PRESENT VALUE SAVINGS REGARDING THE
- 21 UNFUNDED ACCRUED LIABILITY.
- 22 (E) A PLAN IN PLACE FROM THE COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE, OR
- 23 TOWNSHIP TO MITIGATE THE INCREASE IN HEALTH CARE COSTS AND MAY
- 24 INCLUDE A WELLNESS PROGRAM THAT PROMOTES THE MAINTENANCE OR
- 25 IMPROVEMENT OF HEALTHY BEHAVIORS.
- 26 (6) MUNICIPAL SECURITIES ISSUED UNDER SUBSECTION (1) OR (3) BY
- 27 A COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP, AND CURRENTLY OUTSTANDING,

- 1 SHALL NOT EXCEED 5% OF THE STATE EQUALIZED VALUATION OF THE
- 2 PROPERTY ASSESSED IN THAT COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP.
- 3 (7) MUNICIPAL SECURITIES ISSUED UNDER SUBSECTION (1) OR (3) BY
- 4 A COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP AND THE INTEREST ON AND INCOME
- 5 FROM THE MUNICIPAL SECURITIES ARE EXEMPT FROM TAXATION BY THIS
- 6 STATE OR A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE.
- 7 (8) A COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP ISSUING MUNICIPAL
- 8 SECURITIES UNDER SUBSECTION (1) OR (3) MAY ENTER INTO INDENTURES OR
- 9 OTHER AGREEMENTS WITH TRUSTEES AND ESCROW AGENTS FOR THE ISSUANCE,
- 10 ADMINISTRATION, OR PAYMENT OF THE MUNICIPAL SECURITIES.
- 11 (9) MUNICIPAL SECURITIES ISSUED UNDER SUBSECTION (1) OR (3) BY
- 12 A COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP SHALL NOT ON A CUMULATIVE
- 13 BASIS EXCEED 75% OF CURRENT UNFUNDED ACCRUED LIABILITIES ON
- 14 POSTEMPLOYMENT HEALTH CARE BENEFITS OWED TO EMPLOYEES OF THE
- 15 COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP THAT EXIST ON THE DATE OF THE
- 16 AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SUBSECTION.
- 17 (10) A COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP SHALL NOT ISSUE A
- 18 MUNICIPAL SECURITY UNDER SUBSECTION (1) OR (3) UNLESS THE COUNTY,
- 19 CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP HAS BEEN ASSIGNED A CREDIT RATING WITHIN
- 20 THE CATEGORY OF A OR HIGHER BY AT LEAST 1 NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED
- 21 RATING AGENCY.
- 22 (11) A COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP SHALL NOT ISSUE A
- 23 MUNICIPAL SECURITY UNDER SUBSECTION (1) OR (3) UNLESS THE PROJECTED
- 24 DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE ASSUMED RATE OF RETURN ON THE HEALTH CARE
- 25 TRUST FUND INVESTMENTS AND THE PROJECTED ACTUAL INTEREST RATE PAID
- 26 ON THE MUNICIPAL SECURITIES ISSUED UNDER SUBSECTION (1) OR (3) IS
- 27 NOT LESS THAN 100 BASIS POINTS.

- 1 (12) BEFORE A COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP ISSUES A
- 2 MUNICIPAL SECURITY UNDER THIS SECTION, THE COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE,
- 3 OR TOWNSHIP SHALL OBTAIN THE APPROVAL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 4 TREASURY. THE DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY SHALL REVIEW THE PROPOSED
- 5 ISSUANCE OF MUNICIPAL SECURITIES AND IF IT VERIFIES THAT THE
- 6 COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS
- 7 SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY SHALL APPROVE THE ISSUANCE OF
- 8 MUNICIPAL SECURITIES UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 9 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 10 unless all of the following bills of the 95th Legislature are
- 11 enacted into law:
