- Sec. 4. A person is eligible for a scholarship award if theperson meets all of the following qualifications:
- (a) Has resided in this state continuously for the preceding12 months and is not considered a resident of any other state.
 - (B) IS A UNITED STATES CITIZEN OR ANY OTHER STUDENT DESCRIBED AS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE TITLE IV, HEA PROGRAM ASSISTANCE UNDER 34 CFR 668.33.
 - (C) (b) Has not graduated from high school at the time of the scholarship examination.
 - (D) (c)—Enrolls in a recognized postsecondary educational
