## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 499. (1) A PERSON AT THE SCENE OF AN EMERGENCY WHO KNOWS
- 2 THAT ANOTHER PERSON IS EXPOSED TO OR HAS SUFFERED GRAVE PHYSICAL
- 3 HARM SHALL GIVE REASONABLE ASSISTANCE TO THE EXPOSED PERSON, UNLESS
- 4 DOING SO WOULD EXPOSE THE PERSON OR OTHERS TO DANGER OR PERIL. AS
- 5 USED IN THIS SECTION, "REASONABLE ASSISTANCE" MEANS CONTACTING A 9-
- 1-1 OPERATOR OR OTHER LAW ENFORCEMENT OR EMERGENCY SERVICE.
- 7 (2) SUBSECTION (1) DOES NOT APPLY IF EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING
- 8 APPLIES:
  - (A) REASONABLE ASSISTANCE IS ALREADY BEING PROVIDED.
- 10 (B) COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENT OF SUBSECTION (1) WOULD

11 INTERFERE WITH PERFORMING IMPORTANT DUTIES OWED TO OTHERS.

- 1 (3) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
- 2 MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY 1 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 3 (A) COMMUNITY SERVICE FOR NOT MORE THAN 360 HOURS.
- 4 (B) IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 60 DAYS.
- 5 (C) A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$2,500.00.
