A bill to amend 1893 PA 206, entitled "The general property tax act,"

(MCL 211.1 to 211.155) by adding section 700.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 700. (1) THE PRINCIPAL RESIDENCE OF A QUALIFIED DISABLED
- 2 VETERAN IS EXEMPT FROM THE COLLECTION OF TAXES UNDER THIS ACT.
- 3 (2) A QUALIFIED DISABLED VETERAN MAY CLAIM AN EXEMPTION UNDER
- 4 THIS SECTION BY SUBMITTING A FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 5 TREASURY TO THE ASSESSOR OF THE LOCAL TAX COLLECTING UNIT IN WHICH
 - THE QUALIFIED DISABLED VETERAN'S PRINCIPAL RESIDENCE IS LOCATED.
 - (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
 - (A) "PRINCIPAL RESIDENCE" MEANS PROPERTY EXEMPT AS PROVIDED UNDER SECTION 7CC.
 - (B) "QUALIFIED DISABLED VETERAN" MEANS A VETERAN WHO IS

- 11 DISCHARGED OR RELEASED FROM HIS OR HER SERVICE WITH AN HONORABLE
