## **HOUSE BILL No. 4662**

March 19, 2009, Introduced by Rep. Melton and referred to the Committee on Energy and Technology.

A bill to amend 1939 PA 3, entitled

"An act to provide for the regulation and control of public and certain private utilities and other services affected with a public interest within this state; to provide for alternative energy suppliers; to provide for licensing; to include municipally owned utilities and other providers of energy under certain provisions of this act; to create a public service commission and to prescribe and define its powers and duties; to abolish the Michigan public utilities commission and to confer the powers and duties vested by law on the public service commission; to provide for the continuance, transfer, and completion of certain matters and proceedings; to abolish automatic adjustment clauses; to prohibit certain rate increases without notice and hearing; to qualify residential energy conservation programs permitted under state law for certain federal exemption; to create a fund; to provide for a restructuring of the manner in which energy is provided in this state; to encourage the utilization of resource recovery facilities; to prohibit certain acts and practices of providers of energy; to allow for the securitization of stranded costs; to reduce rates; to provide for appeals; to provide appropriations; to declare the effect and purpose of this act; to prescribe remedies and penalties; and to repeal acts and parts of acts,"

(MCL 460.1 to 460.11) by adding section 9j.

- 12 (3) THE NOTIFICATION UNDER SUBSECTIONS (1) AND (2) MAY BE
- 13 TRANSMITTED IN THE SAME MANNER AS THE CUSTOMER'S BILLING. THE
- 14 COMMISSION MAY SUPPLEMENT THE METHODS OF PROVIDING THE INFORMATION
- 15 REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (1).
- 16 (4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "PROVIDER" MEANS AN ELECTRIC
- 17 UTILITY, COOPERATIVE ELECTRIC UTILITY, ALTERNATIVE ELECTRIC
- 18 SUPPLIER, OR AN INVESTOR-OWNED BUSINESS ENGAGED IN THE SALE AND
- 19 DISTRIBUTION OF NATURAL GAS WITHIN THIS STATE WHOSE RATES ARE
- 20 REGULATED BY THE COMMISSION.
