A bill to amend 2004 PA 452, entitled

"Identity theft protection act,"

(MCL 445.61 to 445.77) by adding section 14; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

- 1 SEC. 14. (1) THE IDENTITY THEFT PROTECTION COMMISSION IS

- 14 ACTION OF THE IDENTITY THEFT COMMISSION MAY BE TAKEN UPON A VOTE OF
- 15 A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE IDENTITY THEFT COMMISSION.
- 16 (5) THE IDENTITY THEFT COMMISSION MAY ADOPT, AMEND, AND
- 17 RESCIND BYLAWS, RULES, AND REGULATIONS FOR THE CONDUCT OF ITS

- 19 (6) MEMBERS OF THE IDENTITY THEFT COMMISSION SHALL SERVE
- 20 WITHOUT COMPENSATION, BUT ARE ENTITLED TO ACTUAL AND NECESSARY
- 21 EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE PERFORMANCE OF OFFICIAL DUTIES UNDER THIS
