A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 658 (MCL 257.658), as amended by 2002 PA 494.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 658. (1) A person propelling a bicycle or operating a motorcycle or moped shall not ride other than upon and astride a permanent and regular seat attached to that vehicle.
 - (2) A bicycle or motorcycle shall not be used to carry more persons at 1 time than the number for which it is designed and equipped.
 - (3) A moped or an electric personal assistive mobility device shall not be used to carry more than 1 person at a time.
 - (4) A person operating or riding on a motorcycle, and any person less than 19 years of age operating a moped on a public

- 1 thoroughfare shall wear a crash helmet on his or her head. A PERSON
- 2 OPERATING OR RIDING ON A MOTORCYCLE MAY, BUT IS NOT REQUIRED TO,
- 3 WEAR A CRASH HELMET ON HIS OR HER HEAD. Crash helmets shall be
- 4 approved by the department of state police. The department of state
- 5 police shall promulgate rules for the implementation of this
- 6 section pursuant to the administrative procedures act of 1969, 1969
