A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 5491 (MCL 333.5491), as added by 2007 PA 159.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 5491. As used in this part:
- 2 (A) "BIOACCUMULATIVE" MEANS A BIOACCUMULATION FACTOR GREATER
- 3 THAN 1,000, AS DEFINED IN THE GREAT LAKES BINATIONAL TOXICS
- 4 STRATEGY AS DEVELOPED BY THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION
- 5 AGENCY.
- 6 (B) "CHEMICAL" MEANS A SUBSTANCE WITH A DISTINCT MOLECULAR
 - COMPOSITION OR A GROUP OF STRUCTURALLY RELATED SUBSTANCES AND
- 8 INCLUDES THE BREAKDOWN PRODUCTS OF THE SUBSTANCE OR SUBSTANCES THAT
- 9 FORM THROUGH DECOMPOSITION, DEGRADATION, OR METABOLISM.

- 1 (C) "CHEMICAL OF CONCERN" MEANS A CHEMICAL IDENTIFIED BY THE
- 2 DEPARTMENT ON THE BASIS OF CREDIBLE SCIENTIFIC EVIDENCE AS BEING
- 3 KNOWN TO HAVE ANY OF THE FOLLOWING CHARACTERISTICS:
- 4 (i) HARMS THE NORMAL DEVELOPMENT OF A FETUS OR CHILD OR CAUSES
- 5 OTHER DEVELOPMENTAL TOXICITY.
- 6 (ii) CAUSES CANCER, GENETIC DAMAGE, OR REPRODUCTIVE HARM.
- 7 (iii) DISRUPTS THE ENDOCRINE OR HORMONE SYSTEM.
- 8 (iv) DAMAGES THE NERVOUS SYSTEM, IMMUNE SYSTEM, OR ORGANS OR
- 9 CAUSES OTHER SYSTEMIC TOXICITY.
- 10 (v) IS PERSISTENT, BIOACCUMULATIVE, AND TOXIC.
- 11 (vi) IS VERY PERSISTENT AND VERY BIOACCUMULATIVE.
- 12 (vii) HAS BIOLOGICAL OR CHEMICAL PROPERTIES SIMILAR TO
- 13 CHEMICALS THAT MEET ANY OF THE CRITERIA IN SUBPARAGRAPHS (i) TO (vi).
- 14 (viii) THERE ARE INSUFFICIENT CREDIBLE SCIENTIFIC DATA TO ASSESS
- 15 WHETHER THE CHEMICAL MAY MEET THE CRITERIA IN SUBPARAGRAPHS (i) TO
- 16 (vi), BUT PRELIMINARY STUDIES SUGGEST THE CHEMICAL MAY MEET 1 OR
- 17 MORE OF THE CRITERIA IN SUBPARAGRAPHS (i) TO (vi).
- 18 (D) "CHEMICAL OF HIGHEST CONCERN" MEANS A CHEMICAL OF CONCERN
- 19 THAT IS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 20 (i) USED IN CHILDREN'S PRODUCTS.
- 21 (ii) PRESENT IN CHILDREN, HUMAN BREAST MILK, OR CORD BLOOD TO
- 22 AN EXTENT DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT TO BE SIGNIFICANT.
- 23 (iii) PRESENT IN HOUSEHOLD DUST, INDOOR AIR, DRINKING WATER, OR
- 24 ELSEWHERE IN THE HOME ENVIRONMENT TO AN EXTENT DETERMINED BY THE
- 25 DEPARTMENT TO BE SIGNIFICANT.
- 26 (iv) OF SPECIFIC RELEVANCE TO THE HEALTH OF MICHIGAN CHILDREN
- 27 AS DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT.

- 1 (E) (a)—"Child care article" means a product designed or
- 2 intended by the manufacturer to facilitate the sleep, relaxation,
- 3 or feeding of children or to help children with sucking or
- 4 teething.
- 5 (F) (b)—"Children" means individuals who are 7—12 years old or
- 6 younger.
- 7 (G) "CHILDREN'S PRODUCT" MEANS A CONSUMER PRODUCT INTENDED
- 8 PRIMARILY FOR USE BY CHILDREN, OR FOR THE CARE OF CHILDREN, SUCH AS
- 9 BABY PRODUCTS, CAR SEATS, PERSONAL CARE PRODUCTS, TOYS, AND
- 10 CLOTHING, AND ANY CONSUMER PRODUCT CONTAINING A CHEMICAL OF HIGHEST
- 11 CONCERN THAT WHEN USED OR DISPOSED OF WILL LIKELY RESULT IN A CHILD
- 12 OR A FETUS BEING EXPOSED TO THAT CHEMICAL.
- 13 (H) (e) "Consumer" means that term as used in the consumer
- 14 product safety act, 15 USC 2051 to 2085 2089.
- 15 (I) "CONSUMER PRODUCT" MEANS ANY ITEM SOLD FOR RESIDENTIAL OR
- 16 COMMERCIAL USE, INCLUDING ANY COMPONENT PARTS AND PACKAGING.
- 17 CONSUMER PRODUCT DOES NOT INCLUDE A DRUG OR BIOLOGIC REGULATED BY
- 18 THE UNITED STATES FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION, A FOOD OR BEVERAGE
- 19 OR AN ADDITIVE TO A FOOD OR BEVERAGE, A TOBACCO PRODUCT, OR A
- 20 PESTICIDE REGULATED BY THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION
- 21 AGENCY, EXCEPT THAT CONSUMER PRODUCT MAY INCLUDE A CONTAINER OR
- 22 PACKAGING IN WHICH SUCH AN ITEM IS SOLD.
- 23 (J) "DISTRIBUTOR" MEANS A PERSON WHO SELLS CONSUMER PRODUCTS
- 24 TO RETAIL ESTABLISHMENTS ON A WHOLESALE BASIS.
- 25 (K) "MANUFACTURER" MEANS ANY PERSON WHO MANUFACTURES A FINAL
- 26 CONSUMER PRODUCT OR WHOSE BRAND NAME IS AFFIXED TO THE CONSUMER
- 27 PRODUCT. IN THE CASE OF A CONSUMER PRODUCT THAT IS IMPORTED INTO

- 1 THE UNITED STATES, MANUFACTURER INCLUDES THE IMPORTER OR DOMESTIC
- 2 DISTRIBUTOR OF THE CONSUMER PRODUCT IF THE PERSON WHO MANUFACTURED
- 3 OR ASSEMBLED THE CONSUMER PRODUCT OR WHOSE BRAND NAME IS AFFIXED TO
- 4 THE CONSUMER PRODUCT DOES NOT HAVE A PRESENCE IN THE UNITED STATES.
- 5 (1) "PERSISTENT" MEANS A HALF-LIFE IN WATER, SEDIMENT, OR BIOTA
- 6 OF GREATER THAN 7 DAYS, AS DEFINED IN THE GREAT LAKES BINATIONAL
- 7 TOXICS STRATEGY AS DEVELOPED BY THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL
- 8 PROTECTION AGENCY.
- 9 (M) (d) "Person" means an individual, partnership,
- 10 corporation, association, governmental entity, or other legal
- 11 entity.
- 12 (N) "SAFER ALTERNATIVE" MEANS AN ALTERNATIVE THAT, WHEN
- 13 COMPARED TO A CHEMICAL OF CONCERN THAT IT COULD REPLACE, WOULD
- 14 REDUCE THE POTENTIAL FOR HARM TO HUMAN HEALTH OR THE ENVIRONMENT OR
- 15 THAT HAS NOT BEEN SHOWN TO POSE THE SAME OR GREATER POTENTIAL FOR
- 16 HARM TO HUMAN HEALTH OR THE ENVIRONMENT AS THAT CHEMICAL OF
- 17 CONCERN.
- 18 (O) (e) "Toxic substance" means a substance that contains
- 19 lead, or a coating on an item that contains lead, so that the lead
- 20 content is more than 0.06% of the total weight. Toxic substance
- 21 does not include glass or crystal decorative components.
- 22 (P) (f)—"Toy" means an article designed and made for the
- 23 amusement of a minor or for the minor's use in play.
- 24 (Q) "VERY PERSISTENT" MEANS A HALF-LIFE IN WATER, SEDIMENT, OR
- 25 BIOTA OF GREATER THAN 56 DAYS.
- 26 (R) "VERY BIOACCUMULATIVE" MEANS A BIOACCUMULATION FACTOR
- 27 GREATER THAN 5,000.
