THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 435. (1) WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS
- 2 SECTION, THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION SHALL CONDUCT OR
- 3 ARRANGE FOR A FORENSIC AUDIT OF A FIRST CLASS SCHOOL DISTRICT'S
- 4 FINANCIAL OPERATIONS AND RECORDS. AS USED IN THIS SECTION,
- 5 "FORENSIC AUDIT" MEANS AN AUDIT THAT IS DESIGNED TO DETERMINE
- 6 WHETHER THERE HAS BEEN ANY VIOLATION OF LAW OR OF GENERALLY
- 7 ACCEPTED GOVERNMENTAL ACCOUNTING PRACTICES.
- 8 (2) AFTER CONDUCTING THE FORENSIC AUDIT UNDER SUBSECTION (1),
 - IF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION FINDS THAT THERE HAS

- 1 BEEN ANY VIOLATION OF LAW OR OF GENERALLY ACCEPTED GOVERNMENTAL
