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## **HOUSE BILL No. 4973**

May 19, 2009, Introduced by Reps. Lipton, Valentine, Warren, Scripps, Smith, Tyler and Bolger and referred to the Committee on Intergovernmental and Regional Affairs.

A bill to operate certain programs in certain state agencies; to give certain priorities; and to impose certain duties and responsibilities on certain state employees and public employees.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Aggregation" means 2 or more collaborating cities,
- 3 villages, or townships that have combined populations of more than
- 4 35,000 or 2 or more collaborating counties that have combined
- 5 populations of more than 200,000.
  - (b) "Department" means the department of energy, labor, and economic growth.
    - (c) "Energy efficiency and conservation block grant program"

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- 1 means the federal energy efficiency and conservation block grant
- 2 program authorized under the energy independence and security act,
- 3 Public Law 110-140, that is operated by the department.
- 4 (d) "Eligible units of local government" means a city,
- 5 village, township, or county.
- 6 (e) "Nonprofit local government organization" means a
- 7 nonprofit entity incorporated under state and federal law that has
- 8 eligible units of local government as its paid members and has a
- 9 written agreement with those members to work on energy initiatives
- 10 on their behalf.
- Sec. 2. When distributing grants for local government energy
- 12 efficiency projects or local government renewable energy projects,
- 13 including those funded by the United States department of energy,
- 14 the department shall give priority consideration to nonprofit local
- 15 government organizations that are encouraging aggregation of effort
- 16 and increased efficiency among their members.
