

HOUSE BILL No. 4995

May 26, 2009, Introduced by Reps. Lahti, Lindberg, McDowell, Nerat, Booher, Spade, Gonzales, Polidori, Cushingberry and Paul Scott and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to require all official depictions of the state of Michigan to include both peninsulas of the state.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. (1) Any illustration, image, or depiction of the state
2 of Michigan on a publication produced by a department or agency of
3 this state shall include both the Upper Peninsula and the Lower
4 Peninsula of this state.

5 (2) Subsection (1) applies to all documents produced by this
6 state for distribution to any member of the public, including, but
7 not limited to, maps, forms, brochures, pamphlets, and
8 commemorative items, and also applies to digital images made
9 available over the internet by any state department or agency.
