June 4, 2009, Introduced by Rep. Smith and referred to the Committee on Energy and Technology.

A bill to amend 1984 PA 431, entitled

"The management and budget act,"

(MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594) by adding section 214.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 214. NOT LATER THAN DECEMBER 31, 2009, THE DIRECTOR SHALL
- 2 ISSUE DIRECTIVES FOR THE PURCHASE OF AND RETROFITTING OF STATE
- 3 OWNED MOTOR VEHICLES TO ACHIEVE THE GREATEST FUEL EFFICIENCY AND
- 4 USE OF ALTERNATIVE FUELS THAT IS PRACTICABLE AT A REASONABLE COST.
- 5 THE DIRECTIVES SHALL INCLUDE ALL OF THE FOLLOWING GOALS:
- 6 (A) ALL OF THE LIGHTWEIGHT TRUCKS EACH STATE AGENCY PURCHASES
- 7 AFTER DECEMBER 31, 2009 SHALL BE ALTERNATIVE ENERGY VEHICLES AS
- 8 DEFINED IN MCL 207.822. LIGHTWEIGHT TRUCKS USING OTHER FORMS OF
- 9 ALTERNATIVE FUELS SHALL BE PREFERRED TO THOSE USING E85 FUEL, AS
 - THAT TERM IS DEFINED IN SECTION 78 OF THE MICHIGAN STRATEGIC FUND

- 3 PURCHASES ANNUALLY AFTER DECEMBER 31, 2009 FOR PASSENGER TRANSPORT
- 4 SHALL BE ALTERNATIVE ENERGY VEHICLES AS DEFINED IN MCL 207.822.
- 5 (C) ALL STATE OWNED TRUCKS FOR THE MODEL YEARS 2007 AND LATER
- 6 SHALL BE RETROFITTED TO ACHIEVE GREATER FUEL EFFICIENCY OR OPERATE
- 7 ON ALTERNATIVE FUELS THAT REDUCE HARMFUL EMISSIONS IF THE SAVINGS
- 8 FROM THE RETROFIT MAKE IT COST-EFFICIENT TO DO SO.
