THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 11529. (1) A disposal area that is a solid waste transfer facility is not subject to the construction permit and operating license requirements of this part if either BOTH of the following eircumstances exists CONDITIONS ARE MET:
 - (a) The solid waste transfer facility is not designed to accept wastes from vehicles with mechanical compaction devices ACCEPTS UNCOMPACTED SOLID WASTE ONLY.
 - (b) The solid waste transfer facility accepts less than 200

- 1 uncompacted cubic yards OF SOLID WASTE per day.
- 2 (2) A solid waste transfer facility that, UNDER SUBSECTION
- 3 (1), is exempt from the construction permit and operating license
- 4 requirements of this part under subsection (1)—shall NEVERTHELESS
- 5 comply with the operating requirements of this part and the rules
- 6 promulgated under this part.
- 7 (3) Except as provided in subsection (5), a disposal area that
- 8 is an incinerator may, but is not required to, comply with the
- 9 construction permit and operating license requirements of this part
- 10 if both of the following conditions are met:
- 11 (a) The operation of the incinerator does not result in the
- 12 exposure of any solid waste to the atmosphere and OR the elements.

- 14 (4) A disposal area that is an incinerator that AND THAT, AS

- 22 incinerator that is designed to burn at a temperature in excess of
- 23 2500 degrees Fahrenheit is not subject to the construction permit
- 24 requirements of this part.
