- 3 IN A LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GAS BUSINESS IF THE INJURY, DEATH, OR
- 4 PROPERTY DAMAGE WAS CAUSED BY EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 5 (A) AN ALTERATION, MODIFICATION, OR REPAIR OF A LIQUEFIED
- 6 PETROLEUM GAS SYSTEM OR APPLIANCE MADE WITHOUT THE KNOWLEDGE OR
- 7 CONSENT OF THE PERSON ENGAGED IN A LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GAS
- 8 BUSINESS.
 - (B) THE USE OF A LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GAS SYSTEM OR APPLIANCE
