- 1 SEC. 1809A. (1) A PERSON LICENSED IN THE PRACTICE OF MORTUARY
- 2 SCIENCE IS IMMUNE FROM CIVIL LIABILITY FOR THE PROPER DISPOSITION
- 3 OF UNCLAIMED CREMATED REMAINS IF THE PROPER DISPOSITION WAS MADE 6
- 4 MONTHS OR LONGER AFTER THE DATE OF CREMATION AND AT LEAST 30 DAYS
- 5 AFTER THE DATE THE NOTICE REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION IS SENT. A
