HOUSE BILL No. 5266

August 19, 2009, Introduced by Rep. Meadows and referred to the Committee on Labor.

A bill to amend 1974 PA 154, entitled "Michigan occupational safety and health act,"

(MCL 408.1001 to 408.1094) by adding section 140.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 140. (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (6), DURING THE
- 2 CONSTRUCTION, RENOVATION, OR DEMOLITION OF ANY IMPROVEMENT TO REAL
- 3 PROPERTY IN THIS STATE THAT WILL TAKE MORE THAN 2 DAYS, A GENERAL
- 4 CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE NO LESS THAN 1 TOILET FACILITY AT THE
- 5 CONSTRUCTION SITE FOR EACH 10 EMPLOYEES OR FRACTION THEREOF WORKING
- 6 AT THE CONSTRUCTION SITE.
- 7 (2) IF A PERMIT IS REQUIRED FOR CONSTRUCTION, RENOVATION, OR
- 8 DEMOLITION OF ANY IMPROVEMENT TO REAL PROPERTY IN THIS STATE, THE
- APPROPRIATE ENFORCING AGENCY SHALL NOT ISSUE THE PERMIT UNLESS,
 - BEFORE STARTING CONSTRUCTION, RENOVATION, OR DEMOLITION, THE

- 1 GENERAL CONTRACTOR OR ANOTHER PERSON REQUESTING THE PERMIT
- 2 DEMONSTRATES COMPLIANCE WITH THIS SECTION BY PROVIDING THE
- 3 ENFORCING AGENCY WITH EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 4 (A) A WRITTEN AGREEMENT SIGNED BY BOTH THE PARTY REQUESTING
- 5 THE PERMIT AND A TOILET FACILITY PROVIDER THAT ESTABLISHES THE
- 6 RENTAL OF NO FEWER TOILET FACILITIES THAN ARE NECESSARY TO COMPLY
- 7 WITH SUBSECTION (1).
- 8 (B) A WRITTEN AGREEMENT OR AFFIDAVIT DEMONSTRATING EITHER A
- 9 VALID EXEMPTION UNDER SUBSECTION (6) (A) OR (B) OR THAT THE
- 10 CONSTRUCTION, RENOVATION, OR DEMOLITION WILL NOT TAKE MORE THAN 2
- 11 DAYS.
- 12 (3) EACH TOILET FACILITY PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (1) SHALL
- 13 BE OPERATIONAL; MAINTAINED IN A CLEAN AND SANITARY CONDITION; AND
- 14 PROVIDED WITH WATER, HAND SOAP OR SOME SIMILAR CLEANSING OR
- 15 DISINFECTING AGENT, AND TOILET PAPER ADEQUATE TO EMPLOYEE NEEDS.
- 16 (4) A GENERAL CONTRACTOR WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION SHALL BE
- 17 ISSUED A CITATION AND IS RESPONSIBLE FOR A CIVIL PENALTY ASSESSED
- 18 PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 33 TO 45. A THIRD PARTY CONTRACT OR AGREEMENT
- 19 THAT PURPORTS TO ASSIGN THE GENERAL CONTRACTOR'S COMPLIANCE
- 20 OBLIGATIONS UNDER THIS SECTION IS VOID.
- 21 (5) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 22 (A) "CONSTRUCTION SITE" MEANS A LOCATION AT WHICH ANY
- 23 IMPROVEMENT TO REAL PROPERTY IS IN PROGRESS OR WHERE ACTUAL
- 24 CONSTRUCTION, RENOVATION, OR DEMOLITION OF AN IMPROVEMENT TO REAL
- 25 PROPERTY IS IN PROGRESS.
- 26 (B) "EMPLOYEE" INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, A
- 27 SUBCONTRACTOR, SUPPLIER, LABORER, OR ANY OTHER INDIVIDUAL WHO,

- 1 UNDER A CONTRACT OR AN AGREEMENT WITH A GENERAL CONTRACTOR OR
- 2 SUBCONTRACTOR, PROVIDES ANY IMPROVEMENT TO REAL PROPERTY OR
- 3 FACILITATES THE RENOVATION OR DEMOLITION OF AN IMPROVEMENT TO REAL
- 4 PROPERTY AT THE CONSTRUCTION SITE THROUGH THE INDIVIDUAL'S PERSONAL
- 5 LABOR.
- 6 (C) "GENERAL CONTRACTOR" MEANS A PERSON WHO CONTRACTS WITH AN
- 7 OWNER, LESSEE, OR OTHER PARTY TO PROVIDE, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY
- 8 THROUGH CONTRACTS OR AGREEMENTS WITH SUBCONTRACTORS, SUPPLIERS, OR
- 9 LABORERS, SUBSTANTIALLY ALL OF THE MATERIALS OR SERVICES FOR THE
- 10 CONSTRUCTION, RENOVATION, OR DEMOLITION OF IMPROVEMENTS TO REAL
- 11 PROPERTY AT A CONSTRUCTION SITE.
- 12 (D) "TOILET FACILITY" MEANS A FIXED OR PORTABLE FACILITY
- 13 DESIGNED TO COLLECT AND CONTAIN THE PRODUCTS OF BOTH DEFECATION AND
- 14 URINATION AND THAT MEETS APPLICABLE HEALTH STANDARDS. TOILET
- 15 FACILITY INCLUDES BIOLOGICAL, CHEMICAL, FLUSH, AND COMBUSTION
- 16 TOILETS AND SANITARY PRIVIES.
- 17 (6) ALL OF THE FOLLOWING EXEMPTIONS APPLY:
- 18 (A) A PRIVATE RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY OWNER OR PRIVATE
- 19 RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY TENANT PERFORMING A CONSTRUCTION, RENOVATION,
- 20 OR DEMOLITION PROJECT ON HIS OR HER PRIVATELY OWNED OR PRIVATELY
- 21 LEASED RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY IS NOT SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF
- 22 SUBSECTION (1) OR (2) FOR A PROJECT THAT MEETS BOTH OF THE
- 23 FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:
- 24 (i) BEFORE STARTING CONSTRUCTION, RENOVATION, OR DEMOLITION,
- 25 THE PROPERTY OWNER OR TENANT HAS AGREED TO MAKE TOILET FACILITIES
- 26 AVAILABLE FOR USE BY EMPLOYEES WORKING ON THAT RESIDENTIAL
- 27 PROPERTY.

- 1 (ii) TOILET FACILITIES MEETING THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION
- 2 (3) ARE AVAILABLE FOR EMPLOYEE USE ON THE RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY FOR
- 3 THE DURATION OF THE PROJECT.
- 4 (B) A GENERAL CONTRACTOR PERFORMING A CONSTRUCTION,
- 5 RENOVATION, OR DEMOLITION PROJECT ON EITHER RESIDENTIAL OR
- 6 COMMERCIAL PROPERTY IS NOT SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF
- 7 SUBSECTION (1) OR (2) FOR A PROJECT THAT MEETS BOTH OF THE
- 8 FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:
- 9 (i) BEFORE THE CONTRACTOR STARTS CONSTRUCTION, RENOVATION, OR
- 10 DEMOLITION, THE RESIDENTIAL OR COMMERCIAL PROPERTY OWNER HAS SIGNED
- 11 A WRITTEN STATEMENT OR AFFIDAVIT AGREEING TO MAKE TOILET FACILITIES
- 12 AVAILABLE FOR USE BY THE EMPLOYEES WORKING ON THAT PROPERTY.
- 13 (ii) TOILET FACILITIES MEETING THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION
- 14 (3) ARE AVAILABLE FOR EMPLOYEE USE ON THE PROPERTY FOR THE DURATION
- 15 OF THE PROJECT.
- 16 (C) A GENERAL CONTRACTOR FOR A COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION OR THE
- 17 MICHIGAN DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION IS EXEMPT FROM THE
- 18 REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION FOR A CONSTRUCTION CREW WORKING ON A
- 19 PUBLIC ROAD.
