## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 40. (1) A PERSON IN POSSESSION OF PREMISES HAS A DUTY TO
- 2 MAINTAIN THE PREMISES IN REASONABLY SAFE CONDITION. THE OPEN AND
- 3 OBVIOUS NATURE OF A CONDITION OF THE PREMISES DOES NOT RELIEVE THE
- 4 POSSESSOR OF THAT DUTY.
- 5 (2) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO SUSTAINS INJURY TO HIS OR HER PERSON OR
  - PROPERTY BECAUSE OF THE FAILURE OF A PERSON IN POSSESSION OF
  - PREMISES TO MAINTAIN THE PREMISES IN A REASONABLY SAFE CONDITION
  - MAY RECOVER DAMAGES FROM THE PERSON IN POSSESSION OF THE PREMISES.
