

HOUSE BILL No. 5468

September 25, 2009, Introduced by Reps. Haveman, Stanley, Crawford, Hansen, Lund,
Bolger, Walsh and Meekhof and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 2000 PA 305, entitled
"Uniform electronic transactions act,"
by amending section 7 (MCL 450.837).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 7. (1) A record or signature shall not be denied legal
2 effect or enforceability solely because it is in electronic form.

3 (2) A contract shall not be denied legal effect or
4 enforceability solely because an electronic record was used in its
5 formation.

6 (3) If a law requires a record to be in writing, an electronic
7 record satisfies the law.

8 (4) If a law requires a signature, an electronic signature
9 satisfies the law.

10 (5) A JUDGMENT OR ORDER OF A COURT SHALL NOT BE DENIED LEGAL

1 EFFECT OR ENFORCEABILITY SOLELY BECAUSE AN ELECTRONIC RECORD WAS
2 USED IN ITS FORMATION OR AN ELECTRONIC SIGNATURE WAS PLACED ON THE
3 JUDGMENT OR ORDER.
