## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

TITLE

2	An act to define civil rights; to prohibit discriminatory
3	practices, policies, and customs in the exercise of those rights
4	based upon religion, race, color, national origin, age, sex,
5	height, weight, familial status, or marital status, OR
6	BREASTFEEDING; to preserve the confidentiality of records regarding
7	arrest, detention, or other disposition in which a conviction does
8	not result; to prescribe the powers and duties of the civil rights
9	commission and the department of civil rights; to provide remedies

- 14 public accommodation or public service will be refused, withheld
- 15 from, or denied an individual because of religion, race, color,
- 16 national origin, age, sex, or marital status or REFUSED, WITHHELD
- 17 FROM, OR DENIED A WOMAN BECAUSE SHE IS BREASTFEEDING A CHILD; that
- 18 an individual's patronage of or presence at a place of public
- 19 accommodation is objectionable, unwelcome, unacceptable, or
- 20 undesirable because of religion, race, color, national origin, age,
- 21 sex, or marital status; OR THAT A WOMAN'S PATRONAGE OR PRESENCE AT
- 22 A PLACE OF PUBLIC ACCOMMODATION IS OBJECTIONABLE, UNWELCOME,
- 23 UNACCEPTABLE, OR UNDESIRABLE BECAUSE SHE IS BREASTFEEDING A CHILD.
