A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code," (MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 16.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 16. (1) THE SCHOOL DISTRICT MODERNIZATION ADVISORY
- 2 COMMISSION IS CREATED AS A TEMPORARY COMMISSION UNDER SECTION 4 OF

- 18 (9) A WRITING PREPARED, OWNED, USED, IN THE POSSESSION OF, OR

- 20 IN THE PERFORMANCE OF AN OFFICIAL FUNCTION IS SUBJECT TO THE

- 22 (10) MEMBERS OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT MODERNIZATION ADVISORY
- 23 COMMISSION SHALL SERVE WITHOUT COMPENSATION. HOWEVER, MEMBERS OF
- 24 THE SCHOOL DISTRICT MODERNIZATION ADVISORY COMMISSION MAY BE
- 25 REIMBURSED FOR THEIR ACTUAL AND NECESSARY EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE

- 14 AVAILABLE TO SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND THE GENERAL PUBLIC.
- 15 (12) IN PERFORMING ITS DUTIES UNDER SUBSECTION (11), THE
- 16 SCHOOL DISTRICT MODERNIZATION ADVISORY COMMISSION SHALL ATTEMPT TO
- 17 PRESERVE OR ENCOURAGE CLASS SIZES FOR GRADES K TO 3 OF NOT LESS
- 18 THAN 17 OR MORE THAN 19 PUPILS PER CLASSROOM.
