## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3. (1)  $\frac{(a)}{(a)}$  The board of trustees may, by a resolution
- 2 adopted by 2/3 of its members, fix the number of members to
- 3 constitute the board. However, the number of trustees constituting
- 4 the board of trustees shall be not less than AT LEAST 15 nor AND
- 5 NOT more than 54. in number and 15% or more of the trustees shall
- 6 be members in good standing of Baptist churches affiliated with the
- 7 American Baptist churches, U.S.A. Nine trustees shall constitute a
  - quorum for the transaction of business at any meeting of the board.

- 1 At the first meeting of the board, the trustees shall divide
- 2 themselves into 3 classes of 1/3 of the whole number of each as
- 3 nearly as possible. The term of office of the first class shall
- 4 terminate at the expiration of the first year; of the second class
- 5 shall terminate at the end of the second year; and of the third
- 6 class shall terminate at the end of the third year, so that 1/3 of
- 7 the number of trustees shall be ARE chosen by the board annually by
- 8 ballot.
- 9 (2) (b) The board may elect ANY NUMBER OF nonvoting honorary
- 10 trustees. without limit as to number. Honorary trustees shall not
- 11 be ARE NOT included in the number of trustees constituting the
- 12 board of trustees.
