

HOUSE BILL No. 5651

December 8, 2009, Introduced by Reps. Lemmons, Durhal, Cushingberry, Womack, Haugh, Terry Brown, Young, Espinoza, Johnson and Dean and referred to the Committee on Labor.

A bill to specify how certain cities may pay an annual cost of living supplement to employees.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
2 "public employee cost of living supplement act".

3 Sec. 2. A city with a population of 200,000 or more may pay
4 its employees an annual cost of living supplement in addition to
5 the employees' regular wages. The supplement shall be calculated by
6 multiplying an employee's annual wage for the preceding year by the
7 most recently available annual percentage increase in the consumer
8 price index. As used in this section, "consumer price index" means
9 the most comprehensive index of consumer prices available for this
