Sec. 1. The governor may from time to time employ clerks and assistants in addition to those already provided for by law —for service in his or her department, as the governor may consider CONSIDERS necessary. —the THE compensation of those clerks and assistants to—SHALL be determined by the governor and to be—paid from the general fund on the warrant of the state treasurer —in like manner as LIKE the salaries of state officers. are paid.
