THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 4EE. (1) A PERSON SUBJECT TO TAX UNDER THIS ACT MAY
- 2 EXCLUDE FROM GROSS PROCEEDS USED FOR THE COMPUTATION OF THE TAX THE
- 3 SALE OF A QUALIFIED HOME APPLIANCE. AS USED IN THIS SECTION,
- 4 "QUALIFIED HOME APPLIANCE" MEANS A CLOTHES WASHER, DEHUMIDIFIER,
- 5 REFRIGERATOR, OR DISHWASHER THAT MEETS OR EXCEEDS THE APPLICABLE
- 6 ENERGY STAR POWER CONSUMPTION GUIDELINES DEVELOPED BY THE UNITED
- STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY AND THE UNITED STATES
- B DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY.
