## **HOUSE BILL No. 6021**

March 25, 2010, Introduced by Rep. Huckleberry and referred to the Committee on Ethics and Elections.

A bill to amend 1968 PA 317, entitled

"An act relating to the conduct of public servants in respect to governmental decisions and contracts with public entities; to provide penalties for the violation of this act; to repeal certain acts and parts of acts; and to validate certain contracts,"

by amending sections 1, 3a, and 8 (MCL 15.321, 15.323a, and 15.328), section 3a as amended by 1996 PA 203 and section 8 as amended by 1997 PA 145.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:

(a) "Public servant" includes all persons serving any public entity, except members of the legislature and state officers who are within the provisions of section 10 of article 4 of the state constitution as implemented by legislative act. ANY INDIVIDUAL SERVING A PUBLIC ENTITY WITHIN THIS STATE, EXCEPT THE FOLLOWING:

- 6 (b) "Public entity" means the state including all agencies

- 8 agencies thereof, or any non-incorporated public body within the
- 9 state of whatever nature, including all agencies thereof THIS STATE
- 10 OR A PUBLIC OR GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY WITHIN THIS STATE, INCLUDING,
- 11 BUT NOT LIMITED TO, A DEPARTMENT, AGENCY, BRANCH, POLITICAL
- 12 SUBDIVISION, OR PUBLIC BODY CORPORATE OF THIS STATE, OR A PUBLIC
- 13 BODY CORPORATE OF 1 OR MORE POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS OF THIS STATE.
- 14 Sec. 3a. Section 2 shall not be construed to do any of the
- 15 following:
- 16 (a) Prohibit public servants of a city, village, township, or
- 17 county with a population of less than 25,000 from serving, with or
- 18 without compensation, as emergency medical services personnel as
- 19 defined in section 20904 of the public health code, Act No. 368 of
- 20 the Public Acts of 1978, being section 333.20904 of the Michigan
- 21 Compiled Laws 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.20904.
- 22 (b) Prohibit A public servants SERVANT of a city, village,
- 23 township, or county with a population of less than 25,000 from
- 24 serving, with or without compensation, as a firefighter in that
- 25 city, village, township, or county if that firefighter is not any
- 26 of the following:
- 27 (i) A full-time firefighter.

- 1 (ii) A fire chief.
- 2 (iii) A person who negotiates with the city, village, township,
- 3 or county on behalf of the firefighters.
- 4 (c) Limit the authority of the governing body of a city,
- 5 village, township, or county with a population of less than 25,000
- 6 to authorize a public servant to perform, with or without
- 7 compensation, other additional services for the unit of local
- 8 government.
- 9 (d) Prohibit public servants of this state from purchasing at
- 10 a tax sale lands returned as delinquent for taxes under the general
- 11 property tax act, Act No. 206 of the Public Acts of 1893, being
- 12 sections 211.1 to 211.157 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, unless
- 13 otherwise prohibited by the rules of the Michigan civil service
- 14 commission or the department or agency of which that public servant
- 15 is an employee.
- Sec. 8. It is the intention that this act shall THIS ACT IS
- 17 INTENDED TO constitute the sole law in this state and shall
- 18 supersede all other acts in respect to RESPECTING conflicts of
- 19 interest relative to public contracts involving public servants,
- 20 other than members of the legislature and state officers, including
- 21 but not limited to section 30 of 1851 PA 156, MCL 46.30 AND
- 22 SUPERSEDES ALL OTHER ACTS ON THE SUBJECT. This act does not
- 23 prohibit a unit of local government from adopting an ordinance or
- 24 enforcing an existing ordinance relating to conflict of interest in
- 25 ON subjects other than public contracts involving public servants.
