## **HOUSE BILL No. 6242**

June 8, 2010, Introduced by Rep. Clemente and referred to the Committee on New Economy and Quality of Life.

A bill to create the Michigan new economy commission; to provide for its operation; to impose duties on certain state and local officials; to make recommendations and make certain reports; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. (1) The Michigan new economy commission is created
  within the executive office of the governor.
- 3 (2) The Michigan new economy commission shall consist of the 4 following members:
  - (a) The president of the Michigan strategic fund or his or her designee.
  - (b) The director of the Michigan state housing development authority or his or her designee.

- 1 (c) The director of the state transportation department or his
- 2 or her designee.
- 3 (d) The superintendent of public institution or his or her
- 4 designee.
- 5 (e) The following members appointed by the governor, who shall
- 6 be representative of this state geographically, racially, and with
- 7 regard to gender.
- 8 (i) One member of the house of representatives from a list of 2
- 9 or more members selected by the speaker of the house of
- 10 representatives.
- (ii) One member of the house of representatives from a list of
- 12 2 or more members selected by the minority leader of the house of
- 13 representatives.
- 14 (iii) One member of the senate from a list of 2 or more members
- 15 selected by the majority leader of the senate.
- (iv) One member of the senate from a list of 2 or more members
- 17 selected by the minority leader of the senate.
- 18 (v) One member representing new economy businesses.
- 19 (vi) One member representing cultural institutions.
- 20 (vii) One member representing institutions of higher education.
- 21 (viii) One member representing regional economic development.
- 22 (ix) One member representing small businesses.
- 23 (x) One member representing young professional organizations.
- 24 (xi) One member representing leadership organizations.
- 25 (xii) One member representing business media.
- 26 (xiii) One member representing foundations.
- 27 (xiv) One member representing early state business financing.

- 1 (xv) One member representing cities, villages, and townships.
- 2 (xvi) Four members, at large.
- 3 (3) The members first appointed to the Michigan new economy
- 4 commission shall be appointed within 30 days after the effective
- 5 date of this act.
- 6 (4) Members of the Michigan new economy commission shall serve
- 7 for terms of 4 years or until a successor is appointed, whichever
- 8 is later, except that of the members first appointed 8 shall serve
- 9 for 1 year, 8 shall serve for 2 years, and 7 shall serve for 3
- 10 years.
- 11 (5) If a vacancy occurs on the Michigan new economy
- 12 commission, the governor shall make an appointment for the
- 13 unexpired term in the same manner as the original appointment.
- 14 (6) The governor may remove a member of the Michigan new
- 15 economy commission for incompetency, dereliction of duty,
- 16 malfeasance, misfeasance, or nonfeasance in office, or any other
- 17 good cause.
- 18 (7) The first meeting of the Michigan new economy commission
- 19 shall be called by governor. At the first meeting, the Michigan new
- 20 economy commission shall elect from among its members a chairperson
- 21 and other officers as it considers necessary or appropriate. After
- 22 the first meeting, the Michigan new economy commission shall meet
- 23 at least quarterly, or more frequently at the call of the
- 24 chairperson or if requested by 10 or more members.
- 25 (8) A majority of the members of the Michigan new economy
- 26 commission constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at a
- 27 meeting of the Michigan new economy commission. A majority of the

- 1 members present and serving are required for official action of the
- 2 Michigan new economy commission.
- 3 (9) The business that the Michigan new economy commission may
- 4 perform shall be conducted at a public meeting of the Michigan new
- 5 economy commission held in compliance with the open meetings act,
- 6 1976 PA 267, MCL 15.261 to 15.275.
- 7 (10) A writing prepared, owned, used, in the possession of, or
- 8 retained by the Michigan new economy commission in the performance
- 9 of an official function is subject to the freedom of information
- 10 act, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.231 to 15.246.
- 11 (11) Members of the Michigan new economy commission shall
- 12 serve without compensation. However, members of the Michigan new
- 13 economy commission may be reimbursed for their actual and necessary
- 14 expenses incurred in the performance of their official duties as
- 15 members of the Michigan new economy commission.
- 16 (12) The Michigan new economy commission shall do all of the
- 17 following:
- 18 (a) Develop a statewide strategy for the enhancement,
- 19 encouragement, and growth of the new economy in this state and to
- 20 promote through public and private means responsive public policies
- 21 and innovative private sector practices.
- 22 (b) Research and evaluate studies conducted within this state
- 23 and in other states to locate and identify best practices that
- 24 easily transfer to this state.
- 25 (c) Provide recommendations on restructuring economic programs
- 26 within state government to enhance new economy efforts.
- 27 (d) Provide strategies and propose legislation, if necessary,

- 1 to provide linkage between programs to enhance the new economy.
- 2 (e) Establish metrics to measure the effect of the new economy
- 3 on other sectors of the economy by developing and conducting
- 4 extensive statewide research and creating a database from the
- 5 results.
- 6 (f) Foster education and workforce development in the new
- 7 economy sector by stimulating efforts to develop career pathways
- 8 for new industries.
- 9 (g) Research the potential for an online resource directory,
- 10 including, but not limited to, the development and promotion of a
- 11 web-based resource highlighting the new economy and its member
- 12 companies and organizations.
- 13 (h) Research the potential for a comprehensive communications
- 14 program targeting member communities, organizations, stakeholders,
- 15 and interested parties, including, but not limited to, the
- 16 promotion of networking across the new economy sector.
- 17 (i) Research methods to brand Michigan as a new economy
- 18 leader.
- 19 (j) Develop a strategic vision for this state that includes,
- 20 but is not limited to, all of the following:
- 21 (i) Economic development.
- 22 (ii) International issues.
- 23 (iii) Outdoor recreation.
- (iv) Land use.
- (v) Transit.
- 26 (vi) Green initiatives.
- 27 Sec. 2. The Michigan new economy commission shall report to

- 1 the governor the results of its investigation and study, and its
- 2 recommendations together with drafts of legislation, if any, on or
- 3 before July 1, 2011.
- 4 Sec. 3. The Michigan new economy commission shall annually
- 5 submit on or before December 1 a written report of its activities
- 6 during the previous fiscal year to the clerk of the house of
- 7 representatives and the secretary of the senate. The report shall
- 8 include recommendations to the governor regarding proposed changes
- 9 to this act, or any other statute or any rule promulgated pursuant
- 10 to state law, necessary to promote the new economy in this state.
- Sec. 4. This act is repealed on October 1, 2015.
