- 1 Sec. 3113. A person is not entitled to be paid personal
- 2 protection insurance benefits for accidental bodily injury if at
- 3 the time of the accident any of the following circumstances
- 4 existed:
- 5 (a) The FOR A MOTOR VEHICLE OR MOTORCYCLE THAT WAS UNLAWFULLY
- 6 TAKEN, THE person was using a THE motor vehicle or motorcycle,
- 7 which he or she had taken unlawfully, unless the person reasonably
- 8 believed that he or she WAS ENTITLED TO OR THE DRIVER was entitled
- 9 to take and use the vehicle.

- (b) The person was the owner or registrant of a motor vehicle
 or motorcycle involved in the accident with respect to which the
 security required by section 3101 or 3103 was not in effect.
- 4 (c) The person was not a resident of this state, was an
 5 occupant of a motor vehicle or motorcycle not registered in this
 6 state, and was not insured by an insurer which has filed a
 7 certification in compliance with section 3163.
