## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 72. (1) Burning dwelling house Any A person who wilfully
- 2 WILLFULLY or maliciously burns any A dwelling house, either
- 3 occupied or unoccupied, or the contents thereof OF A DWELLING
- 4 HOUSE, whether owned by himself THE PERSON or another, or any A
- 5 building within the curtilage of such-A dwelling house, or the
- 6 contents thereof OF A DWELLING HOUSE, shall be IS quilty of a
- 7 felony , punishable by imprisonment in the state prison FOR not
- 8 more than 20 years, EXCEPT AS PROVIDED UNDER THIS SECTION.
  - (2) IF A PERSON VIOLATES SUBSECTION (1) BY BURNING A DWELLING
- 10 HOUSE THAT IS A MULTIUNIT BUILDING, THE PERSON IS GUILTY OF A
