## **HOUSE BILL No. 6406**

August 25, 2010, Introduced by Reps. Nerat, Liss, McDowell, Lindberg, Haugh, Kennedy, Constan, Ebli, Valentine, Slavens, Lemmons, Donigan and Leland and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 719a (MCL 257.719a), as amended by 2009 PA 32.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 719a. (1) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this
- 2 act, a person shall not operate a towing vehicle to which a mobile
- 3 home or park model trailer is attached on a street or highway if
- 4 that mobile home or park model trailer is more than 45 feet in
- 5 length or more than 60 feet in length when combined with the towing
- 6 vehicle, is more than 12-1/2 feet in height, and has an actual body
- 7 width of more than 102 inches at base rail, unless that person
- 8 possesses either of the following:

- 1 (a) A permit issued by the jurisdictional authority under this
- 2 section.
- 3 (b) A special permit issued by the jurisdictional authority
- 4 under section 725.
- 5 (2) A jurisdictional authority may issue to a mobile home or
- 6 park model trailer transport company, a mobile home or park model
- 7 trailer manufacturer, or a mobile home or park model trailer dealer
- 8 an annual permit to move on a street or highway, in the ordinary
- 9 course of that company's, manufacturer's, or dealer's business, a
- 10 mobile home or park model trailer that conforms to each of the
- 11 following:
- 12 (a) The mobile home or park model trailer is not more than 12
- 13 feet wide.
- 14 (b) The actual body length of the mobile home or park model
- 15 trailer is not more than 80 feet and the combined length of the
- 16 mobile home or park model trailer and towing vehicle is not more
- 17 than 105 feet or the total length of a combination of mobile homes
- 18 or park model trailers is not more than 80 feet and the total
- 19 length of a combination of mobile homes or park model trailers and
- 20 towing vehicle is not more than 105 feet.
- 21 (C) BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 1, 2010, ON ROADS IN THE UPPER
- 22 PENINSULA ONLY THAT ARE DETERMINED BY THE STATE TRANSPORTATION
- 23 DEPARTMENT TO BE SAFE FOR USE UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION, THE MOBILE
- 24 HOME OR PARK MODEL TRAILER IS NOT MORE THAN 17 FEET 10 INCHES HIGH.
- 25 (3) A jurisdictional authority under section 725 may issue a
- 26 special permit for the movement of a mobile home or park model
- 27 trailer on a street or highway within its jurisdiction if the width

- 1 of that mobile home or park model trailer conforms to both ALL of
- 2 the following:
- 3 (a) The mobile home or park model trailer is not more than 16
- 4 feet wide plus normal appurtenances or eaves that extend not more
- 5 than 6 inches from any side of the mobile home or park model
- 6 trailer.
- 7 (b) The length of the mobile home or park model trailer
- 8 complies with subsection (2)(b).
- 9 (C) BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 1, 2010, ON ROADS IN THE UPPER
- 10 PENINSULA ONLY THAT ARE DETERMINED BY THE STATE TRANSPORTATION
- 11 DEPARTMENT TO BE SAFE FOR USE UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION, THE MOBILE
- 12 HOME OR PARK MODEL TRAILER IS NOT MORE THAN 17 FEET 10 INCHES HIGH.
- 13 (4) A person operating a towing vehicle under subsection (3)
- 14 shall transport a mobile home or park model trailer only on the
- 15 lane farthest to the right of that person. A person shall not move
- 16 a mobile home or park model trailer that is 14 or more feet in
- 17 width including an eave of 2 feet when the wind velocity exceeds 25
- 18 miles per hour.
- 19 (5) A jurisdictional authority shall not issue a permit
- 20 described in subsection (2) or (3) for the transport of a mobile
- 21 home or park model trailer on a Saturday, Sunday, legal holiday,
- 22 from the noon before until the noon after a holiday, or during the
- 23 hours between sunset and sunrise.
- 24 (6) A jurisdictional authority shall provide and a person
- 25 operating a towing vehicle shall comply with all of the following
- 26 in a permit issued under this section:
- 27 (a) The date, day, and time period during which a mobile home

- 1 or park model trailer subject to the permit may be moved on a
- 2 highway.
- 3 (b) Notice that the permit is conditioned upon its holder's
- 4 compliance with the permit's terms and with the law.
- 5 (c) Notice that the operator of a towing vehicle transporting
- 6 the mobile home or park model trailer shall operate the towing
- 7 vehicle on a highway as follows:
- 8 (i) At a safe speed and in a safe manner that will not impede
- 9 motor traffic.
- 10 (ii) Only when the surface condition of the highway is not
- 11 slippery.
- 12 (iii) In compliance with seasonal load restrictions.
- 13 (d) For a mobile home or park model trailer and towing vehicle
- 14 that, when combined, are more than 80 feet in length or more than
- 15 12 feet wide, all of the following:
- 16 (i) Notice that the mobile home or park model trailer shall be
- 17 equipped with 2 flashing amber lights on the rear of the mobile
- 18 home or park model trailer and 1 flashing amber light on the top of
- 19 the towing vehicle.
- 20 (ii) Notice that the mobile home or park model trailer shall be
- 21 equipped with stop lights and directional lights on the rear of the
- 22 mobile home or park model trailer.
- 23 (iii) Notice that signs with the words "oversize load" shall be
- 24 displayed on the front bumper of the towing vehicle and the back of
- 25 the mobile home or park model trailer or, in the case of mobile
- 26 homes or park model trailers that are 16 feet wide, notice that
- 27 signs with the words "16-ft wide load" shall be displayed on the

- 1 front bumper of the towing vehicle and the back of the mobile home
- 2 or park model trailer.
- (iv) Notice that the signs identified in subparagraph (iii) shall
- 4 be of durable material, in good condition, with black lettering on
- 5 interstate yellow background, and that each letter shall be of
- 6 block lettering not less than 12 inches high at the front and not
- 7 less than 16 inches high at the rear of the unit.
- 8 (v) Notice that a vehicle escort is required on those roads
- 9 where the state police consider escort vehicles necessary for
- 10 highway safety.
- 11 (7) Signs and other special identification for escort vehicles
- 12 shall conform to state transportation department requirements for
- 13 all escort vehicles for oversized loads.
- 14 (8) For a mobile home or park model trailer being moved
- 15 pursuant to this section or section 725, the distance between
- 16 mobile home or park model trailer axle centers shall not be less
- 17 than 34 inches. The axles and tires shall meet standards
- 18 established by the state transportation department.
- 19 (9) This section does not grant or give authority to the state
- 20 transportation department that did not exist on May 1, 1982, in
- 21 accordance with 23 USC 127.
- 22 (10) A person that violates this section is responsible for a
- 23 civil infraction and may be assessed a civil fine of not more than
- 24 \$500.00. The owner of the towing vehicle may be charged with a
- 25 violation of this section.
- 26 (11) The state transportation commission may order the state
- 27 transportation department to immediately cease issuing all special

- 1 permits to move on the highways of the lower peninsula of this
- 2 state a mobile home or park model trailer that is more than 14-1/3
- 3 feet wide plus normal appurtenances that extend no more than 6
- 4 inches, and an eave that extends no more than 2 feet from the width
- 5 of that mobile home or park model trailer if the state
- 6 transportation commission makes a determination that those permits
- 7 create an unreasonable safety hazard or hazards. The state
- 8 transportation commission shall notify all other jurisdictional
- 9 authorities of a determination made under this subsection. The
- 10 order shall not prohibit the issuance of a special permit for the
- 11 movement of a mobile home or park model trailer if a binding
- 12 contract for the movement of that mobile home or park model trailer
- 13 was executed before the commission determination of an unreasonable
- 14 safety hazard or hazards.
- 15 (12) As used in this section:
- 16 (a) "Jurisdictional authority" means the state transportation
- 17 department, a county road commission, or a local authority that has
- 18 jurisdiction over a street or highway on which a mobile home is
- 19 proposed to be moved.
- 20 (b) "Mobile home" means any of the following:
- 21 (i) A prebuilt housing module.
- 22 (ii) That term as defined in section 2 of the mobile home
- 23 commission act, 1987 PA 96, MCL 125.2302.
- 24 (iii) A section of a mobile home as that term is defined in
- 25 subparagraph (ii).
