HOUSE BILL No. 6528

September 29, 2010, Introduced by Reps. Lund, Polidori and Lori and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled

"The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 303a (MCL 750.303a), as added by 1996 PA 539.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 303a. This chapter does not apply to recreational card
- 2 playing conducted at a senior citizen housing facility OR SENIOR
- 3 CITIZEN'S CENTER THAT IS not licensed by the liquor control
- 4 commission by a senior citizens club or a group of residents of a
- 5 THE senior citizen housing facility OR A GROUP OF SENIOR CITIZENS
- 6 that consists of at least 15 members—INDIVIDUALS who are 60 years
- 7 of age or older under all of the following circumstances:
 - (a) The card playing is conducted solely for the amusement and
 - recreation of the members and guests of the club or group and is

- 1 not conducted for fund-raising. The number of guests participating
- 2 in the card playing shall not exceed the number of club or group
- 3 members participating in the card playing.
- 4 (b) Only bona fide members and employees of the club or group
- 5 participate in the conduct of CONDUCT the activity.
- 6 (c) The card playing is conducted after 9 a.m. and before 12
- 7 midnight.
- 8 (d) The participating cardplayers PAY NOT MORE THAN \$5.00 TO
- 9 BUY INTO THE CARD PLAYING AND bet not more than 25 cents per bet.
- 10 (e) The winnings from 1 hand of cards do not exceed \$5.00
- 11 \$200.00.
- 12 (f) Except for winnings, revenue generated from the activity
- 13 is used for reasonable expenses incurred in conducting the card
- 14 playing, and no person is compensated for participating in the
- 15 conduct of CONDUCTING the card playing.
