SENATE BILL No. 17

January 14, 2009, Introduced by Senator HARDIMAN and referred to the Committee on Senior Citizens and Veterans Affairs.

A bill to amend 1986 PA 288, entitled

"An act to establish a Michigan work-study program for qualified resident students attending eligible postsecondary schools and employed by qualified employers; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies,"

by amending section 3 (MCL 390.1373).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 3. (1) A recognized postsecondary school in this state is eligible to participate in the MWS program if the postsecondary
- 3 school MEETS ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
 - (A) THE SCHOOL is a degree-granting institution approved by the state board of education. $\frac{1}{100}$
 - (B) THE instructional programs are not comprised solely of sectarian instruction or religious worship. , and the

- 6 THE STUDENT IS AN ACTIVE DUTY MEMBER, OR THE SPOUSE OR DEPENDENT
- 7 CHILD OF AN ACTIVE DUTY MEMBER, OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED
- 8 STATES, WHILE THAT ACTIVE DUTY MEMBER IS STATIONED IN THIS STATE
- 9 AND DURING THE STUDENT'S CONTINUOUS FULL-TIME ENROLLMENT IN THE
- 10 ACADEMIC DEGREE PROGRAM IN WHICH HE OR SHE IS ENROLLED IF THAT
- 11 ACTIVE DUTY MEMBER IS TRANSFERRED TO ACTIVE DUTY OUTSIDE OF THIS
- 12 STATE.
- 13 (2) A participating school, at its option, may offer academic
- 14 credit to students enrolled in the MWS program.
