

# SENATE BILL No. 130

January 28, 2009, Introduced by Senators BROWN, BIRKHOLZ, JANSEN, RICHARDVILLE, PAPPAGEORGE and HARDIMAN and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled  
"Michigan election law,"  
by amending section 307 (MCL 168.307), as added by 2003 PA 302.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 307. (1) The appropriate board of canvassers as  
2       prescribed in section 24a or 30a shall canvass the votes for  
3       candidates for school board member and votes for and against a  
4       ballot question at a regular or special election in each school  
5       district. That number of candidates equal to the number of  
6       individuals to be elected who receive the greatest number of votes  
7       cast at the election, as set forth in the report of the board of  
8       canvassers canvassing the votes, based upon the returns from the  
9       election precincts or as determined by the board of canvassers as a  
10      result of a recount, are elected to the office of school board  
11      member. ~~Upon~~ **EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SECTION 24A(4), UPON**

1 completion of the canvass, the board of canvassers shall make a  
2 statement of returns and certify the election of school board  
3 members to the secretary of the school board, the county clerk,  
4 and, if other than the county clerk, the school district election  
5 coordinator.

6 (2) The votes cast for a candidate for school board member or  
7 on a ballot question submitted to the electors at a school election  
8 are subject to recount as provided in chapter XXXIII. An individual  
9 elected to the office of school board member is subject to recall  
10 as provided in chapter XXXVI and in section 8 of article II of the  
11 state constitution of 1963.

12 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect  
13 unless Senate Bill No. 129

14 of the 95th Legislature is enacted into law.
