SENATE BILL No. 204

February 10, 2009, Introduced by Senators OLSHOVE, ALLEN, GARCIA, PAPPAGEORGE, GLEASON, BARCIA, ANDERSON, SCOTT and BASHAM and referred to the Committee on Senior Citizens and Veterans Affairs.

A bill to amend 1985 PA 148, entitled "Self-service storage facility act," by amending sections 4 and 5 (MCL 570.524 and 570.525), as amended by 2000 PA 443.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 4. (1) Upon—EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (3), ON the failure of a tenant to pay the rent FOR THE STORAGE SPACE OR UNIT when it becomes due, the owner may, without notice, not less than 5 days after the date the rent is due, deny the tenant access to the personal property located in the self-service storage facility or self-storage SELF-CONTAINED STORAGE unit.
 - (2) The tenant who signs a rental agreement for storage space at a self-service storage facility shall disclose in writing the

- 1 identity, including name, address, and telephone number, of the
- 2 occupant if the occupant is other than the tenant who signs the
- 3 agreement.
- 4 (3) SUBSECTION (1) DOES NOT APPLY TO PERSONAL PROPERTY OF A
- 5 TENANT WHO IS SERVING ON ACTIVE MILITARY DUTY.
- 6 Sec. 5. (1) An owner's lien under section 3 shall be enforced
- 7 only as provided in this section. AN OWNER'S LIEN SHALL NOT BE
- 8 ENFORCED IF THE TENANT IS SERVING ON ACTIVE MILITARY DUTY.
- 9 (2) The tenant and the person ANY OCCUPANT designated , if
- 10 any, by the tenant in section 4(2) shall be notified OF THE OWNER'S
- 11 INTENT TO ENFORCE THE OWNER'S LIEN by written notice delivered in
- 12 person or by certified mail to the tenant's AND, IF APPLICABLE,
- 13 OCCUPANT'S last known address. The notice shall include all of the
- 14 following:
- 15 (a) An itemized statement of the owner's claim, showing the
- 16 sum-AMOUNT due at the time of the notice and the date when the sum
- 17 AMOUNT became due.
- 18 (b) A demand for payment within a specified time not less than
- 19 14 days after delivery of the notice.
- 20 (c) A conspicuous statement that, unless the claim is paid
- 21 within the time stated in the notice, the personal property will be
- 22 advertised for sale or other disposition and will be sold or
- 23 otherwise disposed of at a specified time and place.
- 24 (d) The name, street address, and telephone number of the
- 25 owner whom the tenant may contact to respond to the notice.
- 26 (3) A notice given pursuant to this section shall be presumed
- 27 delivered when it is deposited with the United States postal

- 1 service and properly addressed with postage prepaid.
- 2 (4) After the expiration of the time given in the notice
- 3 described in subsection (2), the contents of the storage space may
- 4 be moved to another storage space pending its sale or other
- 5 disposition under this act.
- **6** (5) After the expiration of the time given in the notice
- 7 described in subsection (2), except as provided in subsection (6),
- 8 an advertisement of the sale or other disposition shall be
- 9 published once a week for 2 consecutive weeks in a newspaper of
- 10 general circulation in the area where the self-service storage
- 11 facility or self-contained storage unit is located. Regardless OF
- whether a sale may involve INVOLVES the property of more than 1
- 13 tenant, a single advertisement may be used to advertise the
- 14 disposal of property at any 1 THE sale. An advertisement under this
- 15 section shall include ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 16 (a) A brief, general inventory, as described in subsection
- 17 (7), of the personal property subject to the lien that is to be
- **18** sold.
- 19 (b) The address of the self-storage facility or the address
- 20 where the self-contained storage unit is located and the name of
- 21 the tenant.
- (c) The time, place, and manner of the sale or other
- 23 disposition. The sale or other disposition shall not take place
- 24 sooner than 15 days after the first publication of the
- 25 advertisement under this section.
- 26 (6) If there is no newspaper of general circulation in the
- 27 area where the self-service storage facility or self-contained

- 1 storage unit is located, the advertisement shall be posted not less
- 2 than 10 days before the date of the sale or other disposition in
- 3 not less than 3 conspicuous places in the neighborhood where the
- 4 self-service storage facility or self-contained storage unit is
- 5 located.
- **6** (7) The inventory required under subsection (5) shall
- 7 reasonably identify the property. However, a A container,
- 8 including, but not limited to, a trunk, valise, or box that is
- 9 locked, fastened, sealed, or tied in a manner that deters immediate
- 10 access to its contents , may be described as being in such a THAT
- 11 condition, and no A description of that THE container's contents is
- 12 NOT required. However, any A container closed in such a manner may
- 13 be opened and its contents inventoried, and those conducting the
- 14 inventory, the owner, its AND THE OWNER'S employees, agents, and
- 15 representatives shall—ARE not be—liable for incidental damage to
- 16 the container caused by the inventory.
- 17 (8) A sale or other disposition of the personal property UNDER
- 18 THIS SECTION shall conform to the terms of the notification as
- 19 provided in this section , and shall be conducted in a commercially
- 20 reasonable manner.
- 21 (9) Before a sale or other disposition of personal property
- 22 under this section, the tenant may pay the amount necessary to
- 23 satisfy the lien and the reasonable expenses incurred under this
- 24 section to redeem the personal property. Upon receipt of the
- 25 redemption sum AMOUNT, the owner shall return the personal property
- 26 to the tenant. After returning the personal property to the tenant
- 27 under this subsection, the owner shall IS not be liable to any

- 1 person concerning that personal property. If the tenant fails to
- 2 redeem the personal property or satisfy the lien, including
- 3 reasonable expenses under this section, the tenant shall be
- 4 considered to have unjustifiably abandoned the personal property
- 5 and the owner may resume possession of the self-service storage
- 6 facility or self-contained storage unit.
- 7 (10) Before the sale of a motor vehicle, aircraft, mobile
- 8 home, moped, motorcycle, snowmobile, trailer, or watercraft, the
- 9 OWNER SHALL CONTACT THE secretary of state and any other
- 10 governmental agency as may be reasonably expected shall be
- 11 contacted NECESSARY to determine the name and address of the title
- 12 holders or lienholders of those items THE ITEM, and THE OWNER SHALL
- 13 NOTIFY every IDENTIFIED title holder or lienholder shall be
- 14 notified of the time and place of the proposed sale. The owner is
- 15 liable for notifying the holder of a security interest only if the
- 16 security interest is filed under the name of the person signing the
- 17 rental agreement, the tenant, or AN occupant identified in section
- 18 4(2). An owner who fails to make the lien searches required by this
- 19 section shall be IS liable only to valid lienholders injured by
- 20 that failure as provided in section 6.
- 21 (11) Before the sale of personal property under this act, a
- 22 holder of a prior lien on a motor vehicle, aircraft, mobile home,
- 23 moped, motorcycle, snowmobile, trailer, or watercraft to be sold
- 24 may pay the owner the amount of the owner's lien attributable to
- 25 storage of the property, including the reasonable expenses incurred
- 26 by the owner under this section. The amount payable to the owner
- 27 shall not exceed the equivalent of 4 months' rent. A payment made

- 1 to the owner shall be added to the amount of the lien of the prior
- 2 lienholder who made the payment and shall be subtracted from the
- 3 amount of the owner's lien.
- 4 (12) A purchase PURCHASER in good faith of the personal
- 5 property sold under this section takes the property free of any
- 6 right of a person against whom the lien was valid, despite
- 7 noncompliance by the owner with the requirements of this section.
- 8 (13) In the event of a sale under this section, the party A
- 9 PERSON conducting the A sale UNDER THIS SECTION shall distribute
- 10 the proceeds in the following sequence:
- 11 (a) First, to satisfy the owner's liens up to an amount
- 12 equivalent to 4 months' rent, minus any amount already paid the
- 13 owner pursuant to subsection (11).
- 14 (b) Second, to satisfy outstanding balances owed TO prior
- perfected lienholders.
- 16 (c) Third, to satisfy the balance of the owner's liens.
- 17 (14) Any proceeds of the—A sale UNDER THIS SECTION remaining
- 18 after the distribution is made under subsection (13) shall be
- 19 returned to the tenant by mailing the proceeds to the tenant's last
- 20 known address by certified mail and by notifying the tenant by
- 21 first-class mail. If the tenant does not claim the remaining
- 22 proceeds within 2 years after the date of sale, the remaining
- 23 proceeds shall escheat to the THIS state. The owner shall maintain
- 24 proper records of money received in any sale held under this
- 25 section, and the records shall be ARE subject to audit by the state
- 26 department of treasury.
