April 22, 2009, Introduced by Senator CLARKE and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code," (MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1280e.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1280E. (1) IF THE DEPARTMENT DETERMINES THAT A SCHOOL
- 2 DISTRICT IS OPERATING AT LEAST 1 SCHOOL THAT HAS BEEN UNACCREDITED
- 3 UNDER SECTION 1280 FOR 3 CONSECUTIVE YEARS OR HAS FAILED TO ACHIEVE
- 4 THE FEDERAL PUPIL PERFORMANCE STANDARD FOR 5 OR MORE CONSECUTIVE
- 5 YEARS, AND THE SCHOOL DISTRICT HAS THE GREATEST NUMBER OF PUPILS IN
- MEMBERSHIP AMONG ALL SCHOOL DISTRICTS IN THIS STATE, THE DEPARTMENT
 - SHALL NOTIFY THE BOARD OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT THAT THE SCHOOL
- 8 DISTRICT IS REQUIRED TO COMPLY WITH THIS SECTION. BEGINNING WITH
- 9 THE NEXT SCHOOL YEAR THAT BEGINS AFTER THIS NOTIFICATION, THE BOARD

- 1 SHALL INITIATE A PILOT PROJECT IN AT LEAST 1 OF THE SCHOOLS THAT
- 2 IMPLEMENTS A METHOD OF COMPENSATION FOR EMPLOYEES AT THE SCHOOL
- 3 THAT IS BASED ON JOB PERFORMANCE AND JOB ACCOMPLISHMENTS, AS
- 4 DESCRIBED IN SECTION 1250, AND THAT IS BASED IN PART ON IMPROVEMENT
- 5 IN THE AVERAGE DAILY ATTENDANCE OF PUPILS AND SPECIFIED EMPLOYEES

- 14 DETERMINED THAT THE SCHOOL HAS FAILED TO ACHIEVE ADEQUATE YEARLY
- 15 PROGRESS UNDER THE NO CHILD LEFT BEHIND ACT OF 2001, PUBLIC LAW
- 16 107-110, OR HAS FAILED TO MEET A SUCCESSOR FEDERAL STANDARD THAT
- 17 THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION HAS IDENTIFIED AS BEING A
- 18 STANDARD ESTABLISHED BY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT THAT IS BASED ON
- 19 PUPIL PERFORMANCE AND IS REQUIRED TO BE MET IN ORDER TO RECEIVE
- 20 FULL FEDERAL FUNDING.
