

SENATE BILL No. 482

April 28, 2009, Introduced by Senators KAHN and HUNTER and referred to the Committee on Economic Development and Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1956 PA 218, entitled
"The insurance code of 1956,"
(MCL 500.100 to 500.8302) by adding section 3406s.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 3406S. (1) AN EXPENSE-INCURRED HOSPITAL, MEDICAL, OR
2 SURGICAL POLICY OR CERTIFICATE DELIVERED, ISSUED FOR DELIVERY, OR
3 RENEWED IN THIS STATE THAT PROVIDES COVERAGE FOR CHEMOTHERAPY
4 TREATMENT OF CANCER AND A HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION GROUP OR
5 INDIVIDUAL CONTRACT THAT PROVIDES COVERAGE FOR CHEMOTHERAPY
6 TREATMENT OF CANCER SHALL INCLUDE COVERAGE FOR A PRESCRIBED, ORALLY
7 ADMINISTERED ANTICANCER MEDICATION USED TO KILL OR SLOW THE GROWTH
8 OF CANCEROUS CELLS.

9 (2) COVERAGE UNDER SUBSECTION (1) SHALL NOT BE SUBJECT TO ANY

1 PRIOR AUTHORIZATION, DOLLAR LIMIT, COPAYMENT, DEDUCTIBLE, OR
2 COINSURANCE PROVISION THAT DOES NOT APPLY TO INTRAVENOUSLY
3 ADMINISTERED OR INJECTED ANTICANCER MEDICATIONS USED TO KILL OR
4 SLOW THE GROWTH OF CANCEROUS CELLS.

5 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect January
6 1, 2010.
