A bill to amend 2006 PA 384, entitled "Driver education provider and instructor act," by amending section 37 (MCL 256.657).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 37. (1) A segment 1 curriculum shall include both
- 2 classroom and behind-the-wheel driver education course experience.
- 3 The classroom instruction and behind-the-wheel instruction shall be
- 4 integrated, relate to each other, and meet the following

- (a) Each student shall receive not less than 24 hours of classroom instruction. Classroom instruction shall be scheduled to occur as follows:
- (i) Classroom instruction shall occur not more than 2 hours per day.

- $\mathbf{1}$ (ii) Classroom instruction shall occur over the course of 3 or
- 2 more weeks.
- 3 (iii) Classroom instruction of 4 or more hours shall be received
- 4 before the student begins to receive behind-the-wheel instruction.
- 5 (iv) CLASSROOM INSTRUCTION SHALL INCLUDE INFORMATION CONCERNING
- 6 THE LAWS PERTAINING TO BICYCLES AND SHALL EMPHASIZE AWARENESS OF
- 7 THE OPERATION OF BICYCLES ON THE STREETS, ROADS, AND HIGHWAYS OF
- 8 THIS STATE.
- 9 (v) (iv) Behind-the-wheel instruction of 3 or more hours shall
- 10 be completed before classroom instruction terminates.
- 11 (b) Each student shall receive not less than 6 hours of
- 12 behind-the-wheel instruction or substitute hours permitted under
- 13 this subsection. Behind-the-wheel instruction shall be scheduled to
- 14 occur as follows:
- 15 (i) A student shall receive not more than 1 hour of behind-the-
- 16 wheel instruction per day.
- 17 (ii) Not more than 1 student shall occupy the front seat of the
- 18 vehicle with the instructor.
- 19 (iii) A driver education motor vehicle shall contain not more
- 20 than 4 students during behind-the-wheel instruction.
- 21 (iv) Not later than 3 weeks after the last classroom
- 22 instruction has been completed, a student shall complete any
- 23 remaining required behind-the-wheel instruction.
- 24 (v) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a student
- 25 may receive instruction while operating a motor vehicle at a
- 26 multiple vehicle driving facility. One hour of instruction received
- 27 at a multiple vehicle driving facility may substitute as credit for

- 1 1 hour of behind-the-wheel experience. A maximum of 2 hours of
- 2 behind-the-wheel experience can be substituted with instruction
- 3 received at a multiple vehicle driving facility.
- 4 (c) A student shall receive 4 or more hours of behind-the-
- 5 wheel observation time.
- 6 (2) A driver education provider classified for teen driver
- 7 training shall not substitute behind-the-wheel instruction with
- 8 multiple vehicle driving facility experience until the secretary of
- 9 state gives the provider written approval for that substitution as
- 10 provided in this act.
- 11 (3) A driver education provider classified for teen driver
- 12 training shall not substitute behind-the-wheel driving experience
- 13 with simulator device training.
- 14 (4) As used in this section:
- 15 (a) "Integrated" means classroom and behind-the-wheel
- 16 instruction scheduled to include a mix of classroom and behind-the-
- 17 wheel instruction throughout the duration of the driver education
- 18 course, except as otherwise provided in this section.
- 19 (b) "Observation time" means the time a student in a driver
- 20 education course sits in the rear seat of a vehicle and observes
- 21 another student in the front seat behind the wheel operating the
- 22 controls of the vehicle, responding to driving situations, and with
- 23 an instructor sitting in the front seat.
