## **SENATE BILL No. 589**

May 20, 2009, Introduced by Senators KAHN and GILBERT and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1972 PA 106, entitled
"Highway advertising act of 1972,"
by amending section 7a (MCL 252.307a), as added by 2006 PA 447.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 7a. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, the department shall not issue annual permits for new signs on or after January 1, 2007.

- (2) Permits issued by the department before the effective date of the amendatory act that added this section JANUARY 1, 2007 remain in force and valid.
- (3) On and after January 1, 2007, the department shall issue an interim permit or permits to a holder of a valid permit or permits if all of the following conditions are met:
  - (a) The holder of the valid permit or permits is otherwise in

- 1 compliance with this act.
- 2 (b) The holder of the permit or permits surrenders the permit
- 3 or permits to the department upon the removal of a sign structure
- 4 or sign structures that have a valid permit under this act.
- 5 (c) The holder of the permit or permits verifies the removal
- 6 of the sign structure or sign structures in writing to the
- 7 department.
- 8 (d) The department verifies that the sign structure or
- 9 structures have been removed or the removal has been deemed
- 10 effective under this section.
- 11 (e) If a permit holder has a valid annual permit or permits
- 12 for a site or sites where no sign structure exists or no
- 13 construction has begun to build a sign structure on January 1,
- 14 2007, the permit holder may exchange the permit or permits for an
- 15 interim permit under this section or begin construction under the
- 16 valid permit or permits no later than 1 year after January 1, 2007.
- 17 The number of permits that can be received in an exchange shall be
- 18 determined under subsection (4).
- 19 (4) (3) An EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION, AN
- 20 interim permit that is issued under this section shall only be
- 21 utilized for the construction of a new sign structure and shall
- 22 remain in effect without expiration with fees renewed on an annual
- 23 basis. A SIGN CONSTRUCTED PURSUANT TO AN INTERIM PERMIT SHALL NOT
- 24 BE CLOSER THAN 1,000 FEET TO ANOTHER SIGN STRUCTURE ON THE SAME
- 25 SIDE OF THE HIGHWAY ALONG INTERSTATE HIGHWAYS AND FREEWAYS OR 500
- 26 FEET TO ANOTHER SIGN STRUCTURE ON THE SAME SIDE OF THE HIGHWAY
- 27 ALONG PRIMARY HIGHWAYS. AN APPLICATION FOR AN INTERIM PERMIT FOR AN

- 1 EXISTING SIGN STRUCTURE SHALL BE GRANTED IF ALL OF THE FOLLOWING
- 2 CONDITIONS ARE MET:
- 3 (A) THE APPLICATION IS SUBMITTED BETWEEN JULY 1, 2009 AND
- 4 OCTOBER 1, 2009.
- 5 (B) THE EXISTING STRUCTURE IS NOT CLOSER THAN 500 FEET TO
- 6 ANOTHER SIGN STRUCTURE ALONG THE SAME SIDE OF THE HIGHWAY.
- 7 (C) THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE EXISTING SIGN STRUCTURE IS LOCATED
- 8 HAS A POPULATION OF LESS THAN 211,000 AND MORE THAN 175,000 AS
- 9 DETERMINED BY THE MOST RECENT FEDERAL DECENNIAL CENSUS.
- 10 (4) Subject to subsections (2) and (8), a permit holder who is
- 11 exchanging a permit or permits under subsection (2) (e) shall be
- 12 issued 1 interim permit for each of the first 3 permits
- 13 surrendered. For each permit surrendered under subsection (2) (e)
- 14 after the first 3 permits surrendered, a permit holder under
- 15 subsection (2) (e) shall receive 1 interim permit for each 3 permits
- 16 surrendered. A permit holder shall have 1 year from January 1, 2007
- 17 to exchange permits pursuant to subsection (2)(e) and this
- 18 subsection. A permit that is not exchanged pursuant to subsection
- 19 (2) (e) and this subsection cannot be exchanged and shall expire no
- 20 later than 1 year after January 1, 2007.
- 21 (5) The department shall verify that an existing sign
- 22 structure has been removed no later than 30 days after the
- 23 department receives written notice from the permit holder that the
- 24 sign structure has been removed. If the department does not respond
- 25 to the written notice within 30 days after receipt of the written
- 26 notice, then the permit holder shall be deemed to have removed the
- 27 sign structure in compliance with this section.

- 1 (6) A holder of 2 valid permits for a sign structure with 2
- 2 faces who complies with this section shall receive 2 interim
- 3 permits for the construction of a sign structure with 2 faces. A
- 4 permit holder under this subsection shall not receive 2 interim
- 5 permits to construct 2 single-face sign structures.
- 6 (7) A holder of a valid permit for a sign structure with a
- 7 single face is entitled to exchange that permit under this section
- 8 for an interim permit with a single face. A holder of valid permits
- 9 for 2 different single-face structures may exchange the 2 permits
- 10 under this section for 2 interim permits to construct 2 single-face
- 11 sign structures or 2 interim permits to construct 1 sign structure
- 12 with 2 faces.
- 13 (8) A holder of more than 2 valid permits for a sign structure
- 14 with more than 2 faces may exchange the permits under this section
- 15 for a maximum of 2 interim permits. The 2 interim permits received
- 16 under this section shall only be used to construct 1 sign structure
- 17 with no more than 2 faces.
- 18 (9) After construction of a sign structure under an interim
- 19 permit is complete, the department shall issue renewable permits
- 20 annually for the completed sign structure.
- 21 (10) If a permit holder for a sign structure that exists on
- 22 January 1, 2007 requires additional permits for any reason, the
- 23 department may issue a valid renewable permit renewable on an
- 24 annual basis without complying with subsection (2) even if the
- 25 permit holder has more than 2 valid permits as a result.
- 26 (11) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ISSUE A PERMIT FOR A NEW SIGN
- 27 STRUCTURE THAT MEASURES LESS THAN 8 SQUARE FEET FOR SIGNS IN THE

1 CATEGORIES OF SERVICE CLUB SIGNS AND RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION SIGNS.
